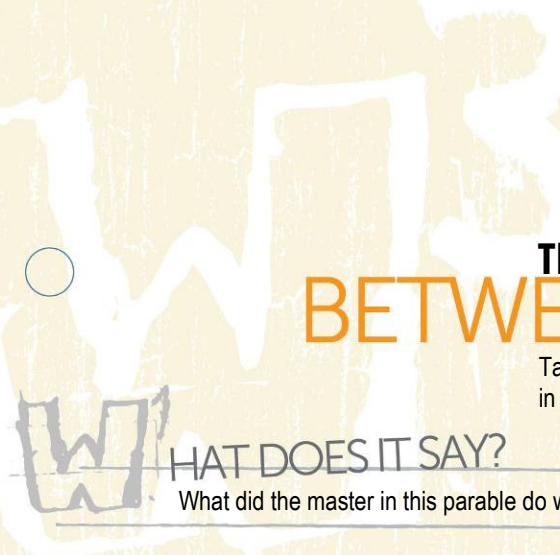


## Bonus Parable - The Mustard Seed (Matthew 13:31-32)
