The Resurrection: New Life

**Lesson Aim: To understand the resurrection
and its importance.**

THE WELCOME

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO SAVES US

Read Worship Scripture: John 11:25-26.

Sing songs and worship God. Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Commander Cosmos script or read storybook.

THE WORD GOD RAISED JESUS FROM THE DEAD

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: God freed Paul and Silas from prison.

Today, we will read about the good news that Paul said was of first importance: Jesus died for our sins, He was buried, and on the third day God raised Jesus to life. That is called the resurrection. It all happened in Jerusalem. Point to Jerusalem, Israel. **We celebrate Jesus' resurrection on Easter. Let's read what happened on that first Easter.** Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: John 20:1-18. Pray.

THE WAY UNDERSTANDING THE RESURRECTION

Today's story tells us what happened three days after Jesus died. How did Jesus die? (On a cross.) **After His body was laid in the tomb, a large heavy stone was used to seal the entrance. No one could come in or out. What happened to that stone?** (It was removed from the entrance.) **Who do you think removed it? Matthew explains that an angel came down from heaven and rolled back the stone.**

At first, Mary didn't understand Jesus had risen. What did she think had happened? (Someone had taken Jesus' body.) **What did Mary do?** (She ran and told Peter and John.) **When Peter and John ran to the empty tomb, what did they see?** (Jesus was not there. They saw His folded burial cloths.) **After Peter and John went home, who did Mary**

see seated in the tomb? (Two angels.) **At first when Jesus spoke to Mary, she didn't realize it was Him because she had seen Him die and be buried. Who did she think He was?** (The gardener.) **When Jesus said Mary's name, she knew it was Him. Jesus told her to tell the others. What did Mary say?** ("I have seen the Lord!")

The story of Jesus dying and rising from the dead is called the Easter story. It is a true story. In your own words, who would like to tell us what happened on the first Easter? (Children take turns.) **What is your favorite part of the Easter story?**

At Easter, believers give thanks and celebrate good news. We give thanks to Jesus for giving His life on the cross to save us from our sins. Sin is doing wrong in God's eyes. Jesus always knew He would die on a cross to pay for our sins. That's why He came to earth.

When Jesus rose from the dead, it showed He won the victory over death. Jesus now lives forever! All who believe in Jesus are forgiven and given a new life forever close to God. Just as Jesus was raised from the dead, one day all who believe in Him will be raised from the dead to live forever with Jesus in heaven. That's good news. Let's take a moment of silence to thank Jesus for dying for us, and thank God the Father for raising Jesus from the dead. Brief silence for prayer.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

1000 years before God raised Jesus from the dead, David foretold that God would not let His Holy One stay in the grave. God's Holy One is His Son Jesus. Reveal Psalm 16:9-10. Read. **We can all rejoice because God truly raised His Holy One, Jesus, from the dead!**

THE GOLDEN BOWL: Pray for individuals. Pray the Lord's Prayer.
