## THE RESURRECTION STORY

**JOHN 20:1-18**  
 Mary was a witness to Jesus' resurrection - his rising from the dead. She saw Jesus die on the cross. Three days later, Mary saw that the stone had been rolled away, and Jesus' body was not in the tomb. Peter and John looked but all they saw was the folded burial cloth. Two angels asked Mary why she was crying. When she turned, she saw Jesus! He was alive! He had risen!
