Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Paul spoke boldly about Jesus while he was under house arrest.

Mailbag: 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 1 John 4:11-12

4. THE WAY PEN PAL LETTER: WE CAN LOVE OTHERS WITH THE LOVE PAUL DESCRIBED

> Today’s letters are about love. In 1 Corinthians, 13:4-7, Paul explained what real love is. In 1 John 4:11-12, John explained why love is so important.

? Have you ever wanted to see God? Me too! We can’t see God completely until we get to heaven, but when we love each other, we can see God’s love.

(Do activity using 15 hearts with words about love from 1 Corinthians 13:4-7.)

> Let’s vote which heart describes the hardest way for you to show love. (Children raise their hands to show the ways of loving they find to be the most difficult.) **God is perfect in all 15 ways of loving you!**

CHRIST CONNECTION> Deuteronomy 6:5

> None of us are perfect at loving others. Years before Paul and John wrote the letters about love, Moses explained God’s commandment about love. Let’s check it out. (Read Deuteronomy 6:5.)

THE GOLDEN BOWL> Pray for individual names and the Lord’s Prayer.
