THE WORD JESUS FILLED THE NETS WITH FISH CLASSROOM PROMISE

Place the fish in the bucket. As children are seated, pretend to be fishing. **Shh! You have to be quiet when you're fishing.** Try several times to get the fish, but don't catch it. Pretend to be increasingly frustrated or make suggestions as to why you can't catch the fish. **I'm so disappointed that I can't catch the fish.**

You know, this reminds me of a Bible story. Some fishermen had been out all night fishing but didn't catch a single fish. They must have been very disappointed. It was their job to catch fish and they would have to go home with nothing. But then, an

amazing miracle happened. Do you remember what a miracle is? (An amazing surprise only God can do.) Let's listen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Luke 5:11.

WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 5:1-11

Read poem. Display visual.

- > The crowd came to hear Jesus,
- > As He taught them by the sea.
- He sat in Simon Peter's boat and said,
- "Let's go fishing in the deep."
- > Simon Peter said, "There are no fish!
- > All night I didn't catch a thing."
- > Then their nets filled with so many fish,
- > The boats began to sink.
- > After this miracle, Jesus said,
- > "Come, follow Me. I'll make you fishers of men."
- > Simon Peter and his friends pulled their boats to shore.
- > They left everything and followed Him!

Simon Peter and the other fishermen knew there had been no fish to catch. It was a miracle when their nets filled with fish! After the miracle, what did Jesus tell them to do? ("Come, follow Me.") What did Simon Peter and the other fishermen do? (They followed Jesus.)
