### THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE GOD OF WONDERS

**Who has a smile for me?** Mention each child's name as they smile.  
**I'm smiling because I believe in Jesus and I know He is always with me. He is with you, too! Let's talk to Jesus right now.** Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us. We believe in You. Amen.**

### THE WORD JESUS HEALED JAIRUS' DAUGHTER CLASSROOM PROMISE

As children are seated, listen to some of their heartbeats. **Who uses a stethoscope?** (A doctor, a nurse.) **Why do doctors and nurses use a stethoscope to listen to your heartbeat?** (To make sure your heart is healthy.) **Sometimes we go to the doctor to make sure we are healthy, but sometimes we go when we are sick.**

**How do you feel when you are sick? When you are sick, who takes care of you?** Name the people mentioned, are sad when you

sick. In our story today, a man named Jairus was sad because his daughter was sick. Let's listen and find out what he did. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Luke 8:50.

### **WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 8:40-42, 49-56**

Read poem. Display visual.

- **A crowd came to see Jesus.**
- **A man named Jairus came, too.**
- **He begged Jesus to heal his daughter.**
- **Jesus said, "I'll come with you."**
- **Then someone said, "Don't bother,**
- **Poor Jairus' daughter is dead."**
- **"Don't be afraid, Jairus. Just believe,**
- **And she will be healed," Jesus said.**
- **When he saw the people at Jairus' house,**
- **"Don't cry, she's just asleep," He said.**
- **Jesus went to her room and took her hand,**
- **And said, "My child, get up from your bed!"**
- **At once, she woke and stood up.**
- **She opened up her eyes,**
- **He said, "Give her something to eat!"**
- **Her parents were so surprised!**

**What did Jesus say to Jairus about his daughter?** (She will be healed.) **Jesus told Jairus, the sick girl's father, to just believe. Turn to your neighbor and say, "Just believe."**
