# **Feeding the Big Crowd**

Lesson Aim: To know by sharing with others, you can be part of God's miracles.

### THE WORSHIP

Who God is: Jesus as the God of Wonders

#### THE WORD

Bible Story: John 6:3-13

What He has done: Jesus fed the big crowd.

## **CRAFT: TWO FISH AND FIVE LOAVES**

**Purpose:** To remind the children of the story of Jesus feeding the big crowd.

**Supplies:** Craft template, sturdy colored paper, paper lunch bag, clay, glue or glue sticks, crayons or markers, optional: wiggly eyes or eye stickers

**Prepare:** For each child, use the template to print and cut out 2 fish from sturdy colored paper and a label from sturdy white paper. Fold down (or cut off) the top of the lunch bag so the bag is half the original height.

**Teacher Tip:** For loaves, purchase children's play dough, make your own, or cut small loaves from paper.

**Optional:** You may choose to have the children attach a wiggly eye or eye sticker on top of each fish eye.

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Give each child a handful of clay.
- 2. Show the children how to make a "loaf of bread" by pulling off a small piece of clay and rolling it into a ball. Children make five small loaves of bread and place them in their lunch sack.
- 3. Give each child two fish and two eyes. Attach an eye to each fish.
- 4. Place the two fish in the bag with the loaves of bread.
- 5. Attach the label to the bag.
- 6. If there is time, children may decorate their lunch bags and fish with crayons.

#### **Ages 2-3 Craft Discussion:**


- **How many small fish did the boy share?** (Two small fish.)
- > Who did Jesus share the fish and loaves with? (The crowd.)
- **How many baskets were filled with leftovers?** (Twelve.)
- > The Bible says, "Share with others." With whom can you share the story of this miracle? Children say names of family and friends.

#### **Ages 4-5 Craft Discussion:**

- > How many small fish did the boy share? (Two.)
- ➤ Who did Jesus share the fish and loaves with? (The crowd.)
- > How many baskets were filled with leftovers? (Twelve.)
- > Who remembers our Whisper Verse? Let's say it with our motions right now! Say the Whisper Verse together with the hand motions.
- > The Bible says, "Share with others." With whom can you share the story of this miracle? (Children respond.)
