To celebrate the coming of Jesus as a family, light candles on your Advent wreath. (A circle of greenery and four candles; place one additional candle in the center to be lit on Christmas Eve as the Christ candle.) This week, gather your family to light four candles and read Luke 2:8-16. Discuss what it may have been like to hear the angels say, "Glory to God in the highest."
