Unit 3, Lesson 16

Ascending Into Heaven

Luke 24:50-53

Running time: Approximately 6 minutes

Set: The Worship Illustration series for God of Wonders Units 1-4 is set in and around a remote jungle airstrip on an uncharted island north of Togo. It is the home of the Bonzai Brother's Flight School. The set should in some way denote the beginning of a journey; a dilapidated airplane hanger covered with vines and cargo netting. There is a cargo crate that contains the Bible. When it is opened, lights flash and a sound effect or theme song plays. For added interest, build windows, entrances and levels where the characters and puppets can pop up unexpectedly.

Characters: Chauncey is a former World War 1 British Air Force pilot turned missionary. He is one of the two Bonzai Brothers. Mumsy, a former nurse and commander in the Women's Air Brigade, is the Bonzai Brothers' mother. She is loving but very forceful and commands authority. 800 Pound Gorilla is a fur-covered arm and hand that only speaks in gibberish.

Plot: Mumsy returns! Chauncey asks her to tell the story of how Jesus went up to His throne. We learn we should joyfully praise Jesus as He sits on His throne in heaven.

<u>Costumes</u>: Chauncey: Brown Bomber jacket, khaki pants, aviator cap and goggles, work boots, scarf; Mumsy: White wig, colorful blouse, culottes, furry boots, hat

Props: Bible, large envelope.

Sound effects (SFX):

- 1. Intro music suggestion: "The Entertainer" by Scott Joplin
- 2. Plane flying
- 3. Plane engine sputter and crash
- 4. Ambulance sirens
- 5. Cargo Crate theme song suggestion: "There Can Be Miracles" from Disney's The Prince of Egypt soundtrack
- 6. Jungle drums
- 7. Outro music suggestion: "The Entertainer" by Scott Joplin

Visual effects (VFX):

- 1. Video Intro: Black and white footage of experimental flight and failures in the Wright Brothers era (available at ResourceWell.org)
- 2. Ambulance lights
- 3. Fog
- 4. Cargo crate contains the Bible. Whenever it is opened, light shines out and theme song plays
- 5. Scripture slide: While He was blessing them, He left them and was taken up into heaven. Luke 24:52
- 6. Closing Slide: "It's incredible but true, what the God of Wonders can do!"

Adaptations:

- 1. Sound Effects: instead of using recorded effects, have children make the sounds
- 2. Voiceovers: may be spoken off stage

Video Intro Voiceover

Since the dawn of time, man has longed to fly like the birds! (image of man with wings trying to fly) Over in England, those amazing twin flyboys, the Bonzai Brothers, were making their first flight...and **crashing** (image of a failed test flight) ...(image of another failed test flight), and crashing ...and crashing (image of another failed test flight)...and, of course...crashing! (image of another failed test flight) Could it be possible that God would now use their "special talents," in the remotest places on Earth. (animated plane flying over map) **Journey with** us now to their island getaway to see what has become of the long lost Bonzai **Brothers! And see the Wonders that God** can do! (SFX: "The Entertainer")

Chauncey (enter at hangar)

Tally ho! Colonel Bonzai, here! I've been waiting anxiously for Mumsy and Popsy and 800 Pound Gorilla to arrive. Today is the day they're supposed to return from their vacation to Easter Island. Oh wait, I think I hear them now. (SFX: Plane flying) Yes, there she is! Hullo Mumsy!

<u>Mumsy</u> (SFX: Plane engine sputter and crash) **Oh, dear! Look out below!**

Chauncey

Duck and cover! (<u>SFX/VFX</u>: ambulance lights, fog, sirens)

Mumsy (enter at hangar)

Jolly good! I made it! A perfect landing! Now, where's my little boy?

Chauncey

Here I am, Mumsy!

Mumsy (hugs him)

Give Mumsy a hug! Oh, I missed you boys so very much. We had such a wonderful time on Easter Island. Popsy and 800 Pound Gorilla frolicked about like two little children. They never found any giant Easter eggs, but we did find an old friend of yours.

Chauncey

Who might that be, Mumsy?

<u>Mumsy</u>

Some chief something or other, he gave us a letter for you. Oh, 800 Pound Gorilla!

<u>Gorilla</u> (enters at stage with letter) Bluh-bluh-bluh-bluh-bluh.

Chauncey

Wait a tick, if you are there and 800 Pound Gorilla is there, where's Popsy?

<u>Mumsy</u>

Oh, he decided to swim back.

Chauncev

What? Swim?! Mumsy, that's over 2,000 miles!!

Mumsy

Oh, you know your father - he won't get bored.

Chauncey

I'm not worried about him getting bored! I'm worried about him getting eaten by sharks!

Mumsy

I'd be more worried about the sharks! You know how Popsy loves to wrestle with ocean beasties.

Gorilla

Bluh-bluh-bluh-bluh-bluh.

Mumsy

Oh, I'm terribly sorry, 800 Pound Gorilla. Chauncey, he wants you to take your letter so he can tell Pepper about our trip.

Chauncey (takes letter)

Thank you, 800 Pound Gorilla.

Gorilla

Bluh-bluh. (exits)

Chauncey

Oh my, it's from our old friend Chief Howzyermomanem!

Mumsy

Who?

Chauncey

Chief Howsyermomanem - he's the ruler of Easter Island. I haven't seen him in years. I wonder what he wants.

Mumsy

Well, open it up and find out.

Chauncey

Okay, here goes. (Open and close envelope, <u>SFX</u>: drums while envelope is open) **He always** communicates by jungle drums. (Open and close envelope. <u>SFX</u>: drums while envelope is open)

Mumsy

Well, how do you know what it says?

Chauncev

I speak fluent jungle drum. (Open and close envelope, <u>SFX</u>: drums while envelope is open) It says he's welcoming his son home from a long battle. Hey Ho.

Mumsy

Hey Ho Howzyermomanem? Oh yes, we met him; he's a perfectly lovely young man. It's so good to have him home.

<u>Chauncey</u> (Open and close envelope, <u>SFX</u>: drums while envelope is open) **The chief** invites all of us to see his son's welcome home ceremony.

Mumsy

Oh, that's a lovely ceremony! All eyes watch the chief's son as he receives his headdress and goes up the steps to take His rightful seat by his father. And when he sits down, everyone applauds!

Chauncey

I say, Mumsy, that reminds me of the story that you used to tell Algernon and me when we were small boys. Do you remember?

Mumsv

How could I forget? The story of the day Jesus was taken up into heaven!!!

Chauncey

Oh, Mumsy, would you tell it again, for old time's sake?

Mumsy

Of course, I will, dear. Let's get the Bible out right now! (SFX: "There Can Be Miracles," VFX: Light shines from Cargo Crate) Ah yes, here it is! Now remember dear, this took place after Jesus had risen from the dead and had appeared to His followers many times. He had even filled their fishing net with a miracle catch of fish!

Chauncey

Yes, and He ate breakfast on the shore with them too!

Mumsv

That's right, and then He led them straight out to the village of Bethany.

Chauncey

Oh, Mumsy, please read us the part that comes next!

Mumsy (SFX: Scripture Slide)

Jesus lifted up His hands and blessed them. "While He was blessing them, He left them and was taken up into heaven." It was a miracle!

Chauncey

A miracle!

Mumsy A miracle!

Chauncey

A miracle! And that was always my favorite part, Mumsy! That was when I knew that Jesus was Lord!

Mumsy

And that's when the Lord Jesus took his rightful place in heaven!

Chauncey

And when I was young boy, He took His rightful place in my heart!

Mumsy

You know, kids, just like Chauncey we can all let Jesus take His rightful place as the Lord of our hearts!

Chauncey

And we can all do what the disciples did when they saw Jesus being taken up into heaven.

Mumsy

Oh, that's my favorite part! They joyfully went to the temple to praise the Lord.

Chauncey (VFX: Closing Slide)

The Lord Jesus is incredible! And you know what we Bonzais like to say! Let's all say it together: "It's incredible but true, what the God of Wonders can do!"

(SFX: "The Entertainer")

Mumsv

Jolly Good, Chauncey! Ta-ta, kids! May the Lord Jesus live in your hearts forever!

Chauncev

And be sure to praise Him forever too!

Mumsy

Love and Kippers!

(they exit)
