### THE WORD JESUS APPEARS TO HIS FRIENDS CLASSROOM PROMISE

God made us so we can hear, see, touch, smell, and taste. Let's sing a song about how God made us. Sing to the tune of "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes."

(Point to each body part.)

#### WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 24:36-48

Read poem. Display visual.

- **After Jesus rose from the dead,**
- **He appeared to His followers and said,**
- **"Peace be with you," but they were afraid.**
- **He said, "It is Me!" And they were amazed!**
- **He asked if they had something to eat.**
- **They gave Him some fish and He helped them believe.**
- **He proved that the Bible was true. He explained,**
- **That to keep God's promises was why He came.**
- **Jesus reminded them of all they had seen.**
- **He said, "You are witnesses of these things."**
- **We are witnesses in that same way;**
- **Let's tell of all His wonderful acts today!**

**A witness is someone who sees something happen and tells others. Who did Jesus say His witnesses were?** (His friends.) **If you believe Jesus did these miracles and you tell others about them, then you are His witnesses, too!**
