Creating the World: Days 3 & 4

Lesson Aim: To know how God filled
the heavens and the earth.

THE WELCOME TREASURE CHEST

WHISPER VERSE AND SIGN LANGUAGE: "It was good."

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

It's Praise Time—our time to sing praise to God who created us. What does "create" means? (To make something.) On the first day of creation, God made light, day, and night. Let's sing our Bible Memory Verse Song while we give our offering to the God who created the heavens and the earth. Sing: "In the Beginning" while collecting the offering.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

On the second day, God made the sky and clouds. Today, we will find out what He made on the third and fourth days. He filled the heavens with the stars, sun, and moon, and He filled the land with plants, trees, and flowers! Sing: "Let Everything That Has Breath."

When God made all these things, He saw that they were good. That is today's Whisper Verse. Let's try it together. Review the Whisper Verse. Include sign language.

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

God made so many amazing things for us to enjoy. Each of His creations tells us God loves us. Sing: "I Will Listen."

THE WORD GOD FILLED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH CLASSROOM PROMISE

Last time, we learned about the very first miracle of all—when God created the heavens and the earth. Today, we will find out what He

did next. Let's open our Bible to the first book of the Bible, Genesis. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 1:10.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:9-19

Read poem. Display visual.

- On the first day,
- God made light.
- On the second day,
- God made the sky.
- And God saw that it was good.

- On the third day,
- God made land and seas.
- He filled the land
- With plants and fruit trees.
- And God saw that it was good.

- On the fourth day,
- God put the sun in the sky
- With the moon and stars
- So we'd know day from night.
- And God saw that it was good.

What did God say about the land and the seas He made? (He saw that it was good.) Let's find our answer in the Bible. Read Genesis 1:10b from the teacher's Bible.

Who created light? (God.) How did He create it? (God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.) Let's say our Whisper Verse together: "Let there be light." Include sign language or hand motions.
