Dear God, we are so glad you made us to be friends with You and with each other. Thank You, God. Amen.

THE WORD GOD CREATED A FRIEND FOR ADAM CLASSROOM PROMISE

On the first six days of creation, God made all the things in the world. Let's see if you can remember what God made. Remove the items from the box children mention the creations they represent. Give hints as needed.

- Flashlight: First day of creation—God created day and night
- ➤ Water: Second day—God separated the water and the sky
- Plant (or tree): Third day—God made land, seas, plants, and trees.

- Sun, moon, stars: Fourth day—God made the sun, moon, and stars.
- Toy fish, bird: Fifth day—God made birds, flying things, and fish.
- Toy animal, toy person: Sixth day—God made animals, creeping things, and people.

Today, we will learn more about the first people God made. Let's listen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 2:18.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:20-31

Read poem. Display visual.

- On the first day, God said, "Let there be light!"
- On the second day, He made the sky above and the waters below.
- God saw it was good and He was right.
- On the third day, God made land and seas, plants and trees.
- On the fourth day, God put the sun in the sky with the moon and stars.
- God saw it was good and He was right.
- On the fifth day, God made birds, flying things, and fish.
- On the sixth day, God made wild animals, creeping things, woman, and man.
- > God saw it was good and He was right.
- God made Adam to care for the land and to name the animals.
- > Then, God made a helper named Eve to be Adam's friend.
- God saw it was good and He was right.
- Just as God created Adam and Eve to be together,
- He made us to be friends and help each other.God saw it was good and He was right.
