## Adam and Eve Sin

Lesson Aim: To know how sin came into the world.

### THE WELCOME

**MEET & GREET:** What is your favorite thing to eat?

**GAME:** Forbidden Marbles

### THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO PROVIDES

Read Worship Scripture: Romans 5:8.

Sing songs and worship God.

Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Bible Barn script or read storybook.

### THE WORD ADAM AND EVE SIN

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: God rested after finishing creation.

Point to Adam and Eve. **Today, we will discover how sin first entered the world when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. They lived in the Garden of Eden.** Point to the Tigris and Euphrates rivers. **Experts may disagree on the exact location of Eden, but it was an actual place in the Middle East near the Tigris and Euphrates rivers.** Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: Genesis 3:1-6, 8-9, 12-13, 21, 23. Pray.

**In the garden, God told Adam he could eat from any tree except for the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Let's see what the serpent said about that.** Read Genesis 3:1-6, 8-9, 12-13, 21, 23.

### THE WAY WE ALL HAVE SINNED

**God made a rule for Adam and Eve to not eat from a certain tree.**

**What did the serpent want Eve to do?** (Eat the forbidden fruit. He told her she would not die.) **How did Adam and Eve disobey God?** (They ate the forbidden fruit.) **Disobeying God is called sin. Sin is doing wrong in God's eyes. Before Adam and Eve disobeyed God, there was no sin in the world. Now, everyone struggles with sin.**

**What did Adam and Eve do when they heard God coming?** (They

hid.) **Why do you think they hid from God? Adam and Eve realized they had disobeyed God. They tried to hide from Him. Have you ever broken a rule and then tried to hide what you had done?**

**Who did Eve blame when she chose to disobey God's rule?** (The serpent.) **The serpent was wrong to tempt Eve, but was it the serpent's fault she disobeyed?** (No. Eve chose to disobey.) **Who did Adam blame when He disobeyed?** (Eve.) **Eve was wrong to offer the fruit to Adam, but was it Eve's fault He disobeyed?** (No. Adam chose to disobey.) **Have you ever wanted to blame someone else when you chose to disobey?**

**God banished Adam and Eve from the garden. To banish is to force someone to leave and not allow them to return. God had to banish them because He is a good and holy God and cannot be near sin. Adam and Eve's sin separated them from God, but God still loved them and provided for them, even after they sinned. What did God provide for them just before He banished them?** (Animal fur to wear as clothing.)

### **CHRIST CONNECTION:**

**Thousands of years after Adam and Eve were banished for their sin, Paul explains why we have all been separated from God.** Reveal Romans 3:23. Read.

**We all sin. Our sin separates us from God, but God loves us so much that He has provided a way for us to come close to Him. He sent His Son Jesus to pay for our sins so that whoever believes in Him will no longer be separated from God.** If a child would like to know more about this, use the Children's Guide for New Believers for further discussion and prayer.

**THE GOLDEN BOWL:** Pray for individuals. Pray the Lord's Prayer.
