THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO PROVIDES

THE WORD NOAH TRUSTED AND OBEYED GOD

CLASSROOM PROMISE

Hold up the toy hammer. I've decided I want to build something for God. I have my hammer. What else do you think I will need? (More tools, wood, nails, a plan.) Show children the ark (or boat). Noah built a big boat called an ark for God. Do you think he had everything he needed to build the ark? (Yes.) Yes, God gave Noah everything he would need to build the ark. Let's listen to

our story. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 6:22.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 6-9

Read poem. Display visual.

- God told Noah how to build an ark,
- So when the flood came, he would be saved.
- Noah did everything just as God commanded Him.
- Noah trusted and obeyed.

- Noah brought the animals two by two
- And his family on board.
- Then God closed the door of the ark,
- And for 40 days the rain poured.

- The world and all its mountaintops
- Were covered in water from the flood.
- But the ark was safe and when the rain stopped
- To find dry land, Noah sent out a dove.

- God told Noah, "Come out of the ark,"
- After the dove found dry land.
- God's rainbow is the sign of His promise
- To never flood the whole world again.

What did Noah do when God told him to build the ark? (Noah trusted and obeyed.) We can trust and obey God because we know He will always take care of our needs.
