Abraham's Visitors

Lesson Aim: To know God can do anything He promises.

THE WORSHIP

Who God is: The God Who Keeps His Promises

THE WORD

Bible Story: Genesis 15:5-6; 18:1-14

What He has done: God sent three men to say His promise would come true.

AGES 2-3 CRAFT: COUNT THE STARS

Purpose: To help children internalize the Bible story of God's promise to Abraham.

Supplies: Sturdy white paper, yarn, 2 star stickers, tape, crayons or markers

Prepare: For each child, use the template to print and cut out a tent, Abraham, and two stars from sturdy paper. Cut (4) 6-inch pieces of yarn.

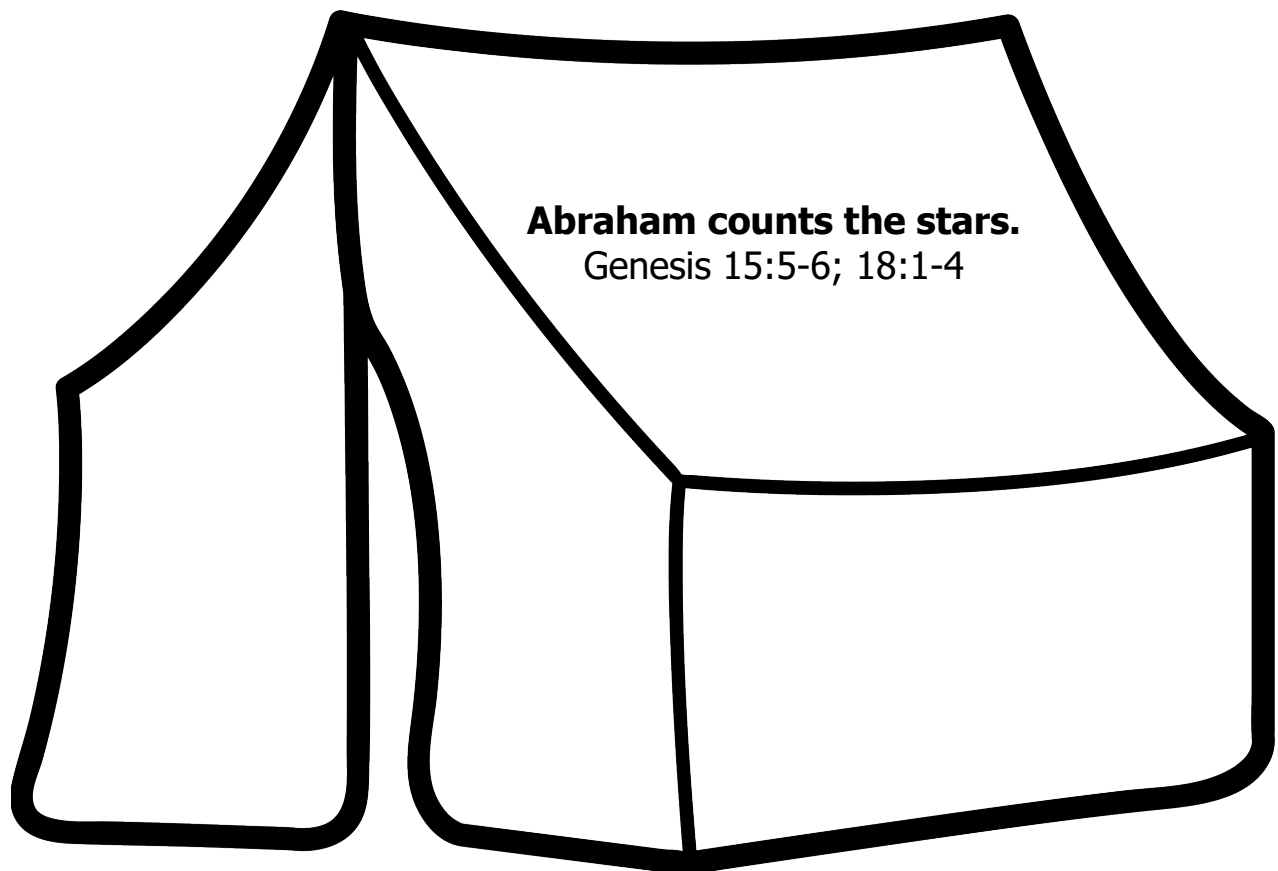
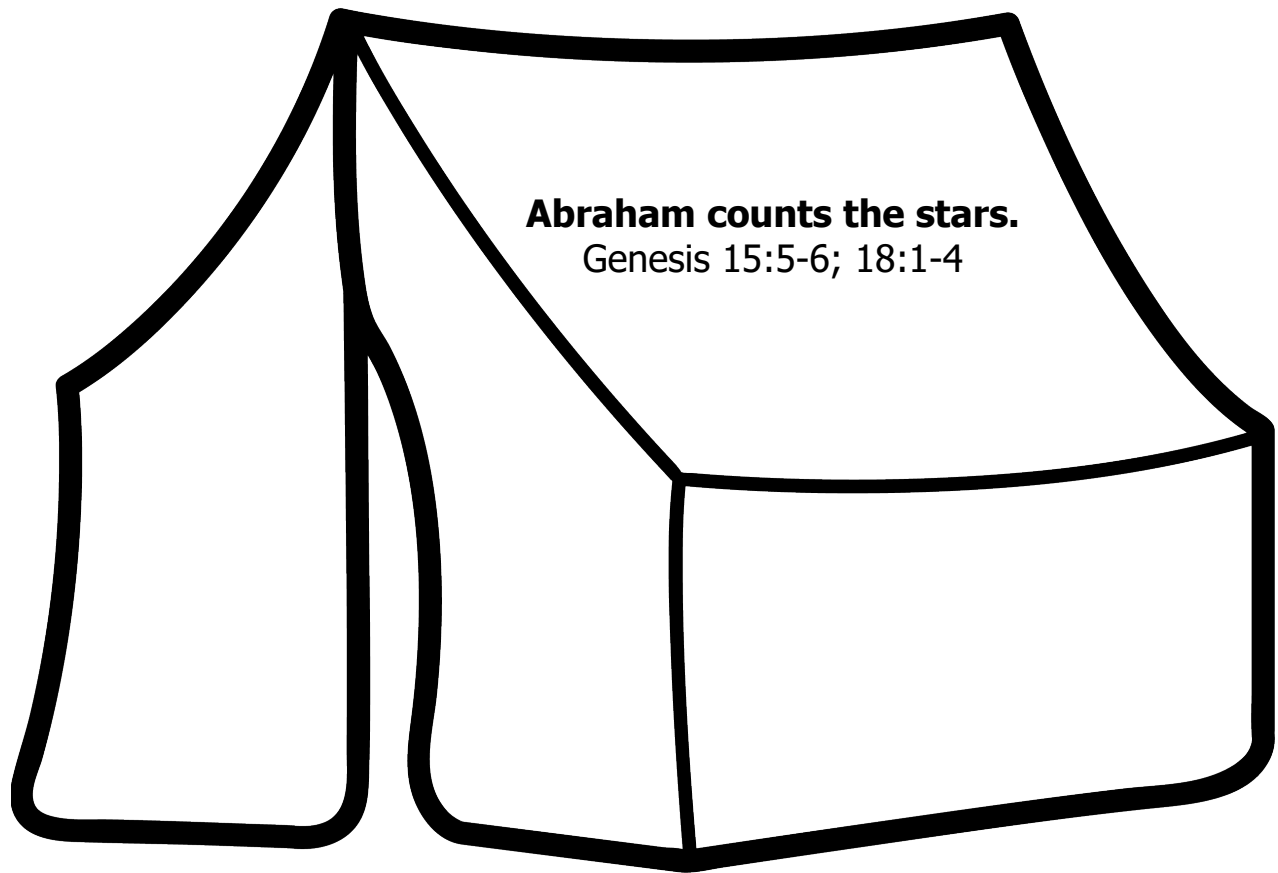
God promised Abraham would have more family members than there are stars in the sky. Everyone who belongs to Jesus is a part of God's big family. Abraham is part of that family too! Let's make a star mobile to show we are part of God's big family!

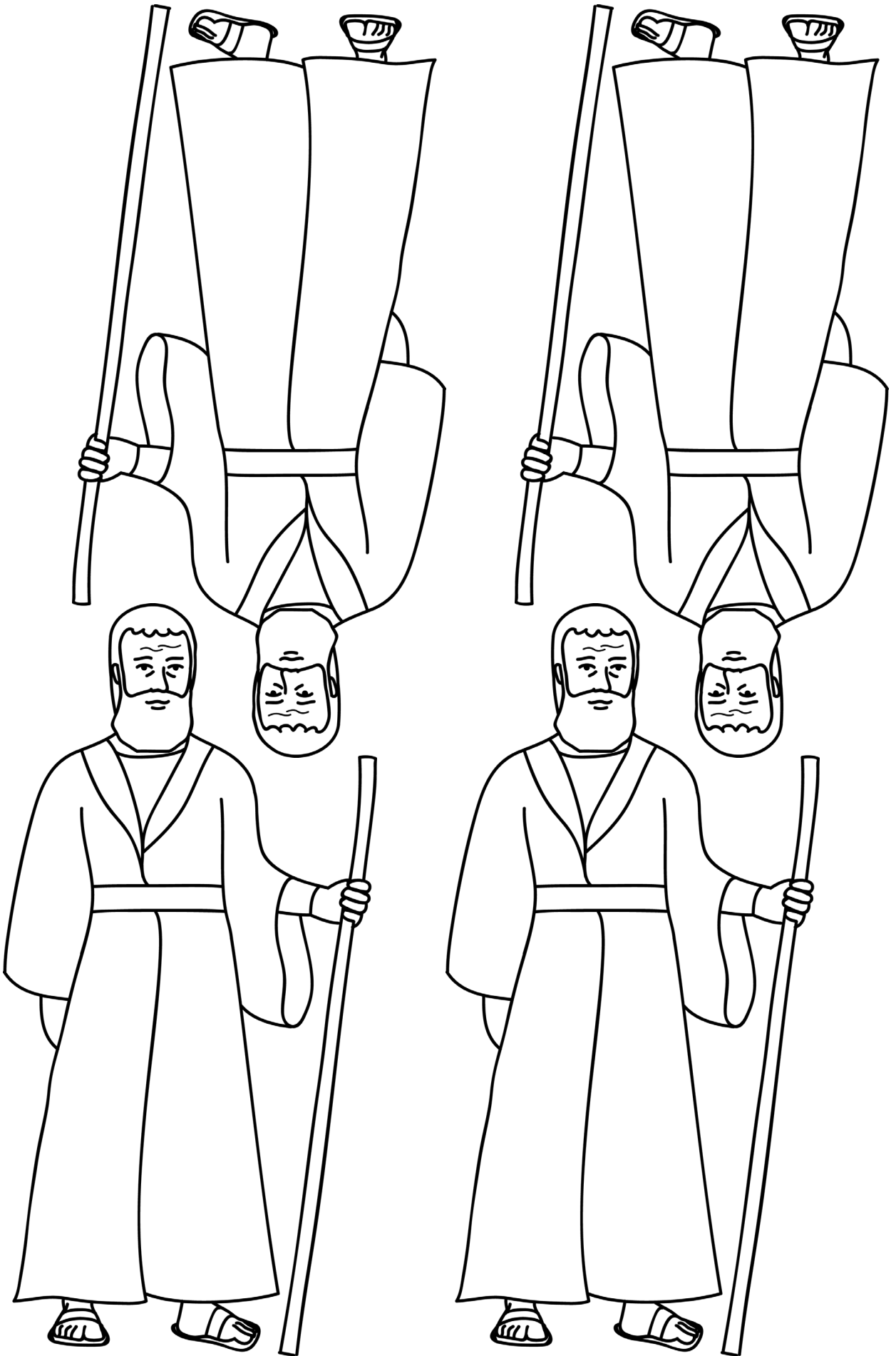
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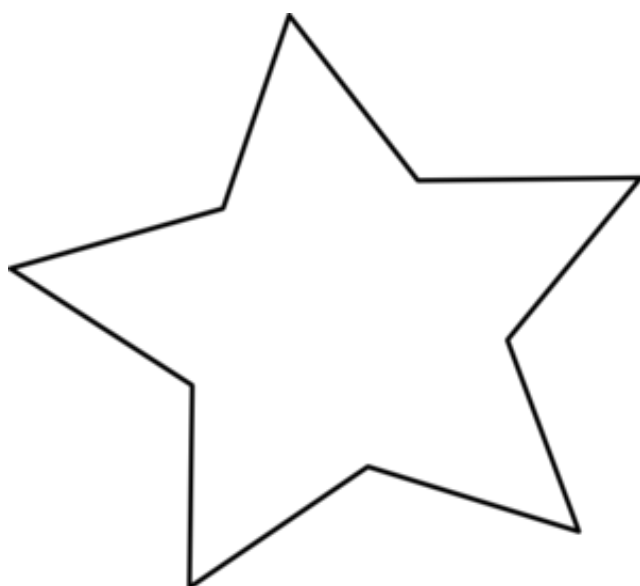
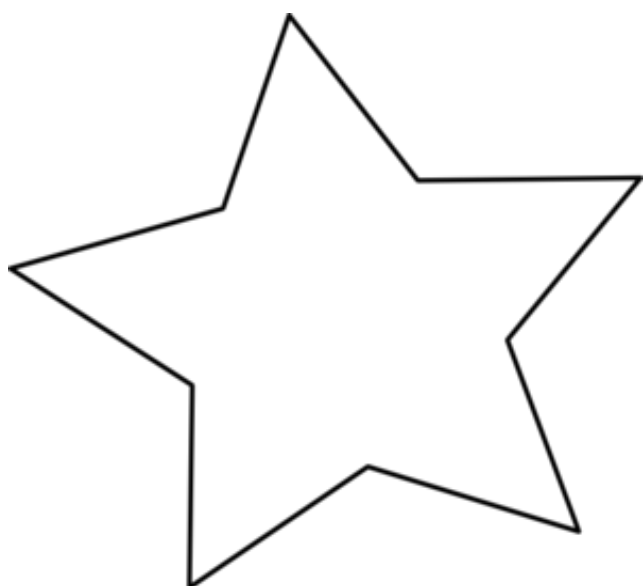
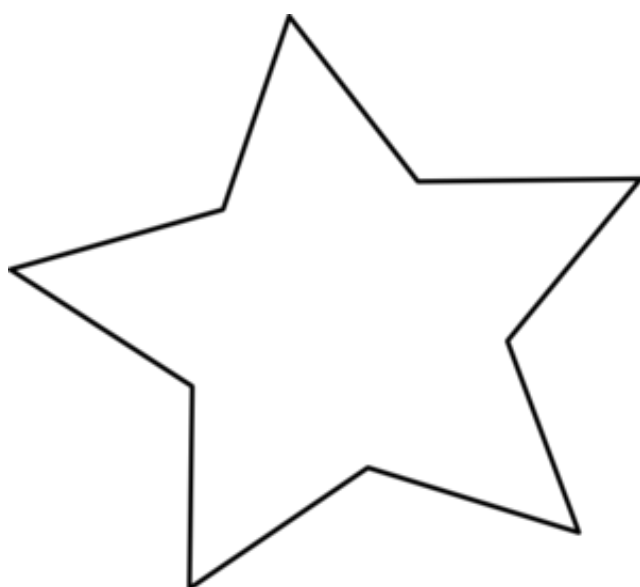
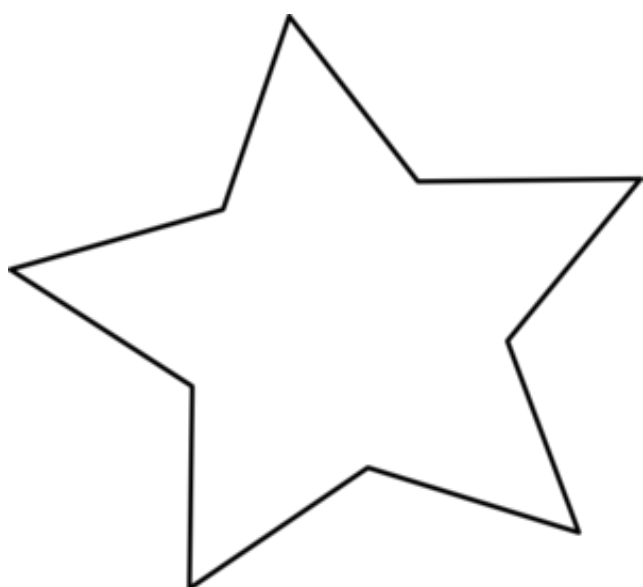
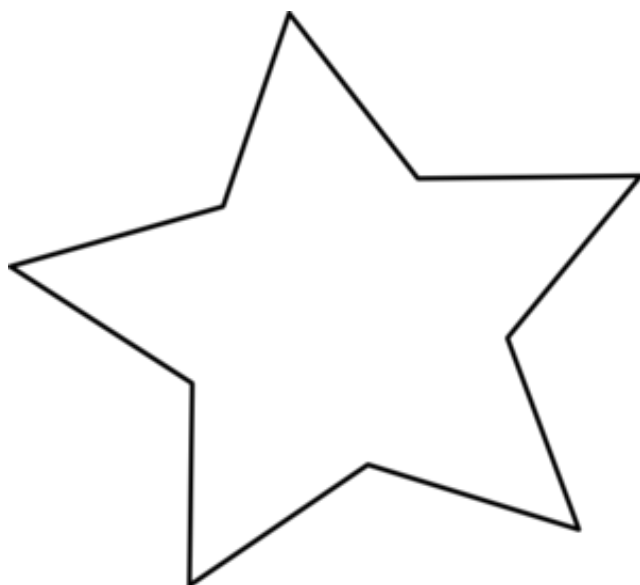
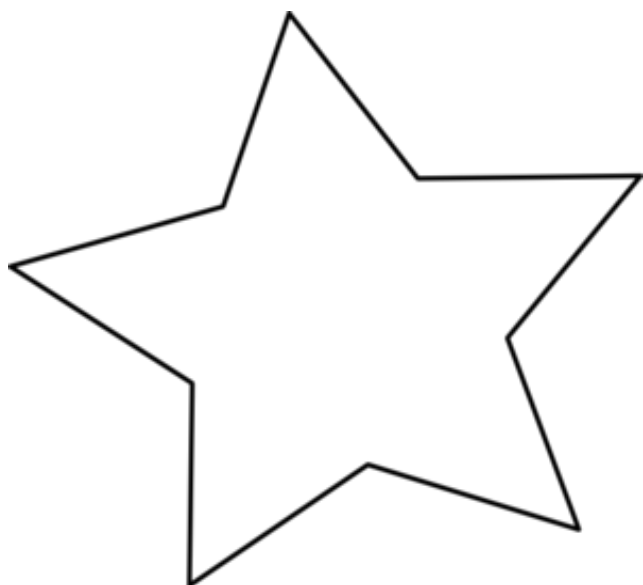
1. Color Abraham, the tent, and the stars.
2. Attach a star sticker to each of the star cutouts.
3. Attach a piece of yarn to the top of the tent. Attach 3 pieces of yarn to the bottom of the tent.
4. Tape Abraham to the middle string hanging down from the tent.
5. Tape a star to each of the other two strings hanging down from the tent.

Craft Discussion:

- **Abraham's visitors told him God's promise would soon come true. What was God's promise?** (Abraham would have as many children as there were stars in the sky.)
- **God promised to give Abraham and Sarah as many children and grandchildren as there were stars in the sky. Sarah laughed at this promise because she knew they were too old to have children.**
- **God asked Sarah, "Is anything too hard for Me?" What is the answer to God's question?** (No, nothing is too hard for God.) **God can do anything He promises!**
