Lesson Aim: To know we can trust God with our fears.

THE WORSHIP

Who God is: The God Who Sends

THE WORD

Bible Story: Deuteronomy 1:21-36

What He has done: God sent Joshua and Caleb to spy on the new land.

CRAFT: SPY GLASS

Purpose: To know we can trust God with our fears.

Supplies: Sturdy white and colored paper, 5-6 colorful stickers (or picture labels provided), craft stick, tape or glue, crayons or markers

Prepare: On sturdy white paper, print and cut out a Bible-times city template and a Bible verse label for each child. Optional: If stickers are not available, print a set of black & white or color picture labels for each child.

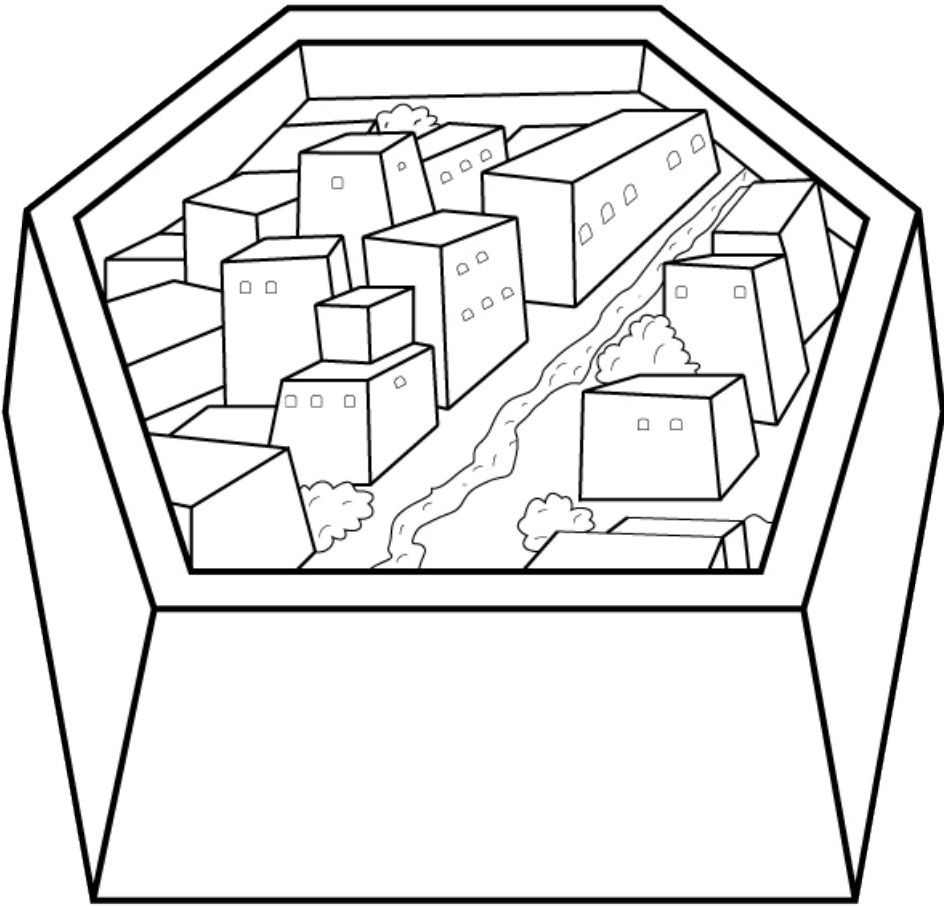
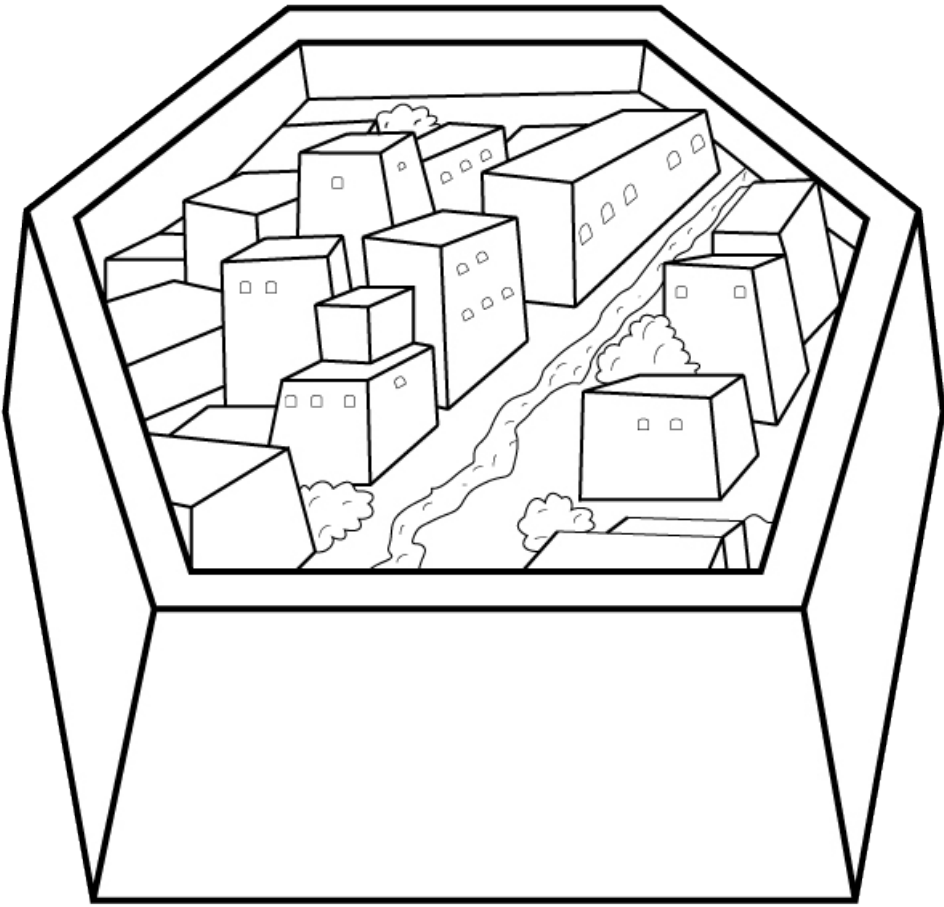
Teacher Tip: Before class, you may choose to mark the area on the sturdy colored paper where children should attach the Bible verse label and stickers so they can be seen after the paper is rolled into the spy glass.

Directions:

1. Color the picture of the Bible-times city.
2. Attach the city to a craft stick.
3. Attach the Bible verse label to a sheet of sturdy colored paper.
4. Decorate the paper with stickers or picture labels and crayons or markers.
5. To create the spy glass, roll the paper lengthwise to create a cylinder.
6. Secure the paper with tape or glue.

Craft Discussion:

- **Look through your spy glass at the city, just like the spies may have done.**
- **Have you ever gone to a new place?** (Children respond.)
- **What was the most amazing thing you saw in that new place?** (Children respond.)
- **Did you see anything frightening in the new place?** (Children respond.)
- **Who was there with you?** (Parents, siblings, friends, God.)
