## <u>THE WORD</u> GOD SENDS HIS PEOPLE TO THE PROMISED LAND CLASSROOM PROMISE

Shake the bag. What do you think I have in this bag? Take the twelve stones out of the bag. Let's count these stones together: 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12.

Today, we will hear how God sent Joshua to lead the people into that new land. Something amazing happened on the way and the people used twelve BIG stones to remember the miracle. Do you remember what a miracle is? (Something only God can do.)

**Let's find out what that miracle was.** Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Joshua 1:6.

**WATCH THE WORD: JOSHUA 1:6-9; 3:15-17; 4:4-9, 17-18** Read poem. Display visual.

- > The Lord told Joshua, "Be strong and brave.
- > I am making you the leader of my people today.
- > Lead them to the Jordan River and say,
- 'We are crossing over to the promised land today!'"
- > The priest went first with the ark of gold;
- > They put their feet in the water as they were told.
- > Right away the Jordan River stopped its flow,
- > Then the water piled up, and Joshua said, "Go!"
- > All the people walked across as dry as ever,
- > While the ark stayed in the middle of the dried-up river!
- > Then the Lord told Joshua to choose 12 men.
- > "Get stones from the middle of the river," He said.
- > They piled up stones by the river's edge
- > To remind us of this story so no one would forget
- > How the Lord made Joshua strong and brave
- > And He stopped the Jordan River from flowing that day.

What did God say to Joshua when He made him leader? ("Be strong and brave.") Who will help you be strong and brave like Joshua? (God.)
