Jesus is Baptized

Lesson Aim: To study the relationship between God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

THE WELCOME

MEET & GREET: What is your favorite kind of bird?

GAME: Underwater

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO IS WITH US

Read Worship Scripture: Pslam 136:26.

Sing songs and worship God. Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Kingdom Adventures script or read storybook.

THE WORD GOD THE FATHER LOVES HIS SON

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Jesus was in His Fathers house with the teachers.

Jesus went to the Jordan River to be baptized after He grew up.

Point to the Jordan River near Bethany, Israel on a map.

Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: Mark 1:1-11. Find It First.

Highlight Key Verse: Mark 1:11. Pray.

Jesus' cousin, John, baptized Him. Baptism is a holy time when we are sprinkled or are dipped underwater as a special sign to show everyone we belong to God. Let's find out exactly what happened when Jesus was baptized. Read Mark 1:1-11.

THE WAY GOD AS THE TRINITY

To get their hearts ready for the coming of Jesus, John preached and baptized people in the Jordan River. John told them Jesus was so powerful that he was not even important enough to untie Jesus' sandals. Right before Jesus began His ministry to the people, John baptized Jesus. That means John helped Jesus go under the water as a sign that Jesus belonged to God and would obey God.

When Jesus came out of the water what did God's voice from heaven say? ("You are my Son, Whom I love; with You I am well pleased.") How do you think Jesus felt to hear His Father say that? How would seeing and hearing this help John the Baptist in his preaching to others about Jesus? (It gave him proof that Jesus is the Son of God.)

One of the greatest mysteries about God is that He is the Trinity which means three-in-one. He is God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. What does each one do in the story? (The Father tears open the heavens and speaks about His Son. Jesus is baptized and comes out of the water. The Holy Spirit descends like a dove.)

God the Father gave His Son, Jesus. God the Son gave His life to save us. God the Holy Spirit lives in the hearts of those who believe in Jesus to guide them in living each day for Jesus. What are some things you love about God as the Father, the Son, and the Spirit?

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Let's see how Isaiah described the Holy Spirit of the Lord 700 years before He came like a dove to rest on Jesus (the Branch). Reveal Isaiah 11:2. Find It First. Highlight. Read.

Who does Isaiah say the Spirit will rest upon? (The Branch, which is Jesus.) In what way does Isaiah say the Holy Spirit will help Jesus? (In wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, and knowledge.) The Holy Spirit helps believers in the same ways. He helps believers be wise, understanding, to make wise plans and follow them, to know and respect the Lord. In what way do you need the Holy Spirit's help?
