PICTURE SCHEDULE: WELCOME TIME

<u>WELCOME</u> > <u>WORSHIP</u> > <u>BIBLE</u> > <u>CRAFT</u> > <u>PRAYER</u> > <u>SNACK</u> > <u>GAMES</u> > <u>COLORING</u> > <u>GOING HOME</u>

Welcome each child as they arrive. Hello _____. I'm glad you are here! Come and see what we are going to do today. Point to each card on the Picture Schedule board. Today, we will WELCOME everyone. We will read the BIBLE story and make a CRAFT. We will have PRAYER time and eat a **SNACK.** We will play **GAMES** and enjoy **COLORING** a picture about today's story.

Open the Treasure Chest to find today's treasure. Child unlocks the Treasure Chest to receive a stamp or sticker of a fish. One day, some men were fishing in the sea. Jesus told them to follow Him. Let this stamp (or sticker) remind you to follow Jesus, just like the fishermen did! Today's Whisper Verse is "Come, follow Me." Teach the Whisper Verse in spoken language and in sign language below. We call it the Whisper Verse so you can whisper it to others.*

SIGN LANGUAGE: "Come, follow Me."

Each time we say today's Whisper Verse, let's say it with three hand motions:

"Come," Point both index fingers out and move hands toward self.

"follow" Make two fists with both thumbs sticking up. The fists move away from the body with the right

hand behind the left hand as if the right is "following" the left.

"Me." Point to self.


Allow children to enjoy free play until everyone has arrived. Let's sing the "Clean Up Song" as we put toys away before Praise Time. Praise any child who helps. Allow several minutes for clean up.

"Clean Up Song": Clean up! Clean up! Everybody, everywhere!

Clean up! Clean up! Everybody do your share!

Gather and seat children in Praise Time area.

*Today's Whisper Verse: "Come, follow Me," Matthew 4:19. The Whisper Verse is a tool to help the children learn a major point in the lesson. It is coupled with sign language or hand motions as a memory aid. The verse is not necessarily chosen from today's Bible story.



PICTURE SCHEDULE: WORSHIP TIME

Choose a child to remove the <u>WELCOME</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Welcome Time**. **Now**, **we will have our Worship Time**.

Children may worship in a large group setting with other classes or in a quiet room with a worship CD or DVD.

Teacher Tip: To help children identify time set aside for worship, play "It's Praise Time!" as children move to a designated place for praise songs, offering, and the worship illustration. Children who are nonverbal may enjoy participating in the music by playing children's percussion instruments such as maracas, jingle bells, wood blocks, or small tambourines. Children who are sensitive to sound may prefer to wear noise reduction headphones.



It's Praise Time—our time to sing praise to the King who is with us. Sing: "Sing Praises." Jesus came to earth to be with us. And He wants us to be with Him and to follow Him. Singing praises, giving our money offering, and praying to Jesus are some ways we can follow Him! Let's start by giving our offering now. Play: "Give Thanks to the Lord" as background music while collecting the offering.

Jesus called His disciples when He said today's Whisper Verse to them. Who can say it with me? Review Whisper Verse together: "Come, follow Me." Include sign language.



Let's find out if our friends Delbert and Lello know about following Jesus. Perform *The Adventures of Delbert and Lello* puppet script or read storybook: Kings & Kingdoms Unit 1, Lesson 4.*



Peter left his boat, his nets and all the fish behind when he decided to follow Jesus. Peter did not turn back to go get all the things he left behind. Jesus wants each of us to follow Him just as Peter did. All who follow Jesus belong to Him. We want to follow Jesus because He loves us so much. Sing: "Jesus Loves Me."

One way we can follow Him is to obey His Word, the Bible. Each time you obey your parents as the Bible says, you are following Jesus. Everyone follow me as we march and sing our Bible Memory Verse Song. Sing: "Children, Obey Your Parents."

Choose a child to remove the <u>WORSHIP</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Worship Time**. **Now**, **we will have our Bible Time**.

Last time, we learned how God said He was pleased with Jesus when Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River. Today, we will hear about how Jesus called His disciples to follow Him. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Luke 5:11.

WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 5:1-11

Read the points below or retell the passage in your own words using the points below as a general guide. To illustrate the story, display a fishing net to remind the children of Simon Peter's net in the story. Have children assist by placing Bible Story figures on a flannel board. Other visual options include Color This Story or a related picture. Optional: To help children focus, have them create a fish from clay or play-dough as they listen.

- Jesus sent some men to fish after they'd caught none all day.
- Because Jesus said so, Simon Peter did obey.
- At once, fish filled their nets until they began to break.
- Friends helped Simon Peter and both boats began to sink.
- Jesus told Simon Peter, "Do not be afraid.
- I'll make you fishers of men. Come, follow Me today."
- They brought their boats and nets and fish to shore.
- > They left all their things to follow Jesus forevermore!



What did Simon Peter and his friends do when Jesus told them to follow Him? (They followed Him.) Let's find our answer in the Bible. Read Luke 5:11 from the teacher's Bible.

What does Jesus tell us to do? ("Come, follow Me.") Our Whisper Verse tells us the answer. Let's say it together: "Come, follow Me." Include sign language or hand motions.



PICTURE SCHEDULE: CRAFT TIME

Choose a child to remove the <u>BIBLE</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Bible Time. Now it is Craft Time.**

CRAFT: FOLLOW ME CARDS

Purpose: For children to create a card to help them commit and remember to follow Jesus.

Supplies: Standard-size sturdy white paper, washable ink pad, paint or marker (for fingerprinting), markers

or crayons

Prepare: Fold the paper in half to make a card. On the cover, print "Come, follow Me." Matthew 4:19 and the outline of a cross.

Directions:

- 1. Color the cross.
- 2. Tell the children, "If you want to follow Jesus, open the card."
- 3. Create a "footprint" in the card.
 - Ink the pinky side of the child's fist.
 - > Press the inked portion of the child's fist onto the paper to create the "foot."
 - Ink the tip of the child's index finger.
 - > Help child use the inked fingertip to create five fingerprint "toes" above the "foot" on the paper.
- 4. Children may color the card, if there is time.

Craft Discussion:

- ➤ Who remembers the Whisper Verse? ("Come, follow Me.") Let's say it together with the hand motions.
- What was Simon Peter's job? (He was a fisherman.) Simon Peter and his friends were regular people just like you and me.
- What did Jesus want Simon Peter and his friends to do after they caught the fish? (Follow Him.)
- ➤ What does Jesus want us to do? (Follow Him.) We can all follow Jesus. The footprint in the card you just made is like your footprint following Jesus!

CIRCLE OF PRAYER/THE LORD'S PRAYER

PICTURE SCHEDULE: PRAYER TIME

WELCOME > WORSHIP > BIBLE > CRAFT > PRAYER > SNACK > GAMES > COLORING > GOING HOME

Choose a child to remove the <u>CRAFT</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Craft Time. Now, it is Prayer Time.**

God made you and He cares for you. He loves to hear you pray with private words or words you say out loud. Let's fold our hands and close our eyes. As I lift up your name to God in heaven, I will lay my hand on your shoulder. Let's pray together.

Dear God, thank You for making us and loving us. We lift up to You a special prayer for ____, ____, ____, (say every name). We pray for our families and friends. Thank You for teaching us how to love one another. Amen. You may add the Lord's Prayer with the word picture book.

<u>PICTURE SCHEDULE: SNACK TIME</u>

WELCOME > WORSHIP > BIBLE > CRAFT > PRAYER > SNACK > GAMES > COLORING > GOING HOME

Choose a child to remove the <u>PRAYER</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Prayer Time**. **Now**, **it is Snack Time**.

Teacher Tip: It is important to keep a record of all dietary restrictions and allergies accessible. Some parents may prefer to bring their child's snack. Depending on the dietary needs of your classroom, you may determine it is best to omit snack time completely.

SNACK: PLENTY OF FISH

Purpose: Children will enjoy a snack while they discuss following Jesus.

Snack: Fish-shaped crackers or candy

Directions:

- 1. Serve snack and drink.
- 2. Let's sing the "Blessing Song." Sing to the tune of "Frere Jacques" or other familiar tune.

God our Father, God our Father. Once again, once again.

Thank You for our blessings. Thank You for our blessings. Amen. Amen.

- 3. Lead discussion below while children enjoy their snack.
 - ➤ Who remembers our Whisper Verse? Choose a child to demonstrate the motions to the Whisper Verse: "Come, follow Me."
 - > Simon Peter and his friends, James and John, had been fishing all night. Did they catch any fish? (No.)
 - ➤ What did Jesus tell them to do? (Go fishing again.)
 - > What happened when they went fishing again? (They caught a lot of fish.)
 - > The fishermen saw Jesus could do amazing things. They wanted to follow Him. Jesus wants you to follow Him, too. You can follow Jesus by listening to Him and obeying.

UNIT 1 GAME OPTIONS

Play one or more of the activities below until the last five minutes of class then proceed to Final Five.

PICTURE SCHEDULE: GAMES TIME

WELCOME > WORSHIP > BIBLE > CRAFT > PRAYER > SNACK > GAMES > COLORING > GOING HOME

Choose a child to remove the <u>SNACK</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished our Snack Time. Now is our time to play Games.**

GAME: SAND SEARCH

Purpose: This sand sifting activity soothes children. The items in the bin can be used to introduce the Bible stories or the Unit 1 Worship Attribute: The King Who Is with Us.

Supplies: Bin or container of clean sand, toy house, toy dove (or bird), toy fish and boat or net, cotton ball

Directions:

- 1. Children take turns reaching into the sand in search of the objects.
- 2. Teacher and children discuss each object as it is located.
- 3. When all the objects have been located, display them on a tabletop or on the surface of the sand.
- 4. Children feel each item as the teacher explains their connection to the Unit 1 Bible stories. The house reminds us that Jesus spent time in God's house when he was a boy. The dove reminds us of the dove that came down from heaven when Jesus was baptized. The fish and boat (or net) remind us that Jesus called fishermen to follow Him. The cotton ball reminds us that a bright cloud came around Jesus when He was on the mountaintop.

GAME: THUMBS UP OR THUMBS DOWN?

Purpose: This nonverbal true-false game helps children master the Bible story or the Unit 1 Bible Memory Verse.

Supplies: None, optional: hand puppet or finger puppets

Directions:

- 1. Teacher or puppet retells today's Bible story or Bible Memory Verse, pausing after each phrase to say, "Thumbs up or thumbs down?"
 - If retelling the Bible study, read it in phrases. For some phrases, state accurate descriptions. For other phrases, replace the truth with silly facts. For example, say, "Jesus grew both wise and short. Thumbs up or thumbs down?" Children respond with thumbs down. "Jesus grew both wise and tall. Thumbs up or thumbs down?" Children respond with thumbs up.
 - If reviewing the Bible Memory Verse, read it in phrases. For some phrases, read it correctly. For other phrases, replace a word with a word that makes no sense. For example, say, "Children, obey your friends, for this is right. Thumbs up or thumbs down?" Children respond with thumbs down. "Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Thumbs up or thumbs down?" Children respond with thumbs up.

GAME: MUSICAL CHAIRS

Purpose: This version of Musical Chairs familiarizes children with the Unit 2 Bible Memory Verse Song. **Supplies:** Unit 1 Bible Memory Verse Song "Children, Obey Your Parents" or "The Word Became Flesh," CD

player, chair for each child

Prepare: Set chairs back-to-back in a row.

Teacher Tip: In this version of musical chairs, no chair is removed; all the children remain in the game. Leave one or more spaces at the end of the row of chairs for any children in wheelchairs. Encourage quick listening and affirm those who are the first to hear the music stop and are seated.

To practice our Bible Memory Verse Song, let's play Musical Chairs.

Directions:

- 1. As the Bible Memory Verse Song plays, children march around the row of chairs and sing.
- 2. The teacher stops the music at different times during the song.
- 3. When the music stops, children find the nearest chair and sit immediately.

GAME: "GOD LOVES YOU" BALL ROLL

Purpose: This game reminds the children that they are each loved by God.

Supplies: Soft, textured ball

Directions:

- 1. Children sit in a circle.
- 2. Teacher rolls the ball to a child and says,

"Child's name, child's name, God loves you.

Roll it to a friend to show God loves them, too!"

- 3. Teacher assists child in choosing another child and rolling the ball to that child.
- 4. Repeat chant to each child as he or she receives the ball.
- 5. Be sure each child has a turn receiving and rolling the ball.

GAME: FOLLOW THE LEADER

Purpose: Children remember Jesus words, "Come, follow Me," by following a leader around the room.

Supplies: None

Jesus said, "Come, follow Me." Let's practice following in this game of "Follow the Leader."

Directions:

- 1. One child marches around the room as the leader.
- 2. Remaining children form a line to "follow the leader" wherever he or she goes.
- 3. Be sure each child has a turn as the leader.

GAME: SCENES FROM KINGDOM ADVENTURES

Purpose: To learn applications of the Unit 1 Bible stories, older children act out the Kingdom

Adventures scripts.

Supplies: The Kingdom Adventures scripts for Lessons 1, 2, 4, and 6

Directions:

- 1. Choose the script that corresponds with today's Bible story.
- 2. Assign each child a character name and improvise so all the children can be their favorite character, a new character, or just take turns being the same character.
- 3. Act it out!

GAME: ACT IT OUT

Purpose: To help children learn Unit 1 stories, children act out the stories in costumes or with stick puppets. **Supplies:** Bible times clothing or pictures of the following characters attached to craft sticks: Mary, Joseph, 12-year-old Jesus, adult Jesus, John the Baptist, dove, disciples, cloud

Directions: With each phrase, teacher says phrase and acts it out with hand motions, then repeats same phrase and motions with children, or children wear costumes and act it out, or children hold craft sticks with characters. You may choose one or more stories.

JESUS AND HIS FATHER'S HOUSE

- > Jesus was born and He began to grow, (Stretch arms wide.)
- 'Til one day when He was twelve years old (Stand tall like a 12 year-old.)
- ➤ He traveled with His parents to Jerusalem. (Walk in place.)
- > But on the trip home they could not find Him. (Searching pose.)
- His mother and father looked high and low. (Look up and down.)
- They asked, "Where did Jesus go?" (Palms up, shrugging shoulders.)
- > They found Him after a three-day search, (Show 3 fingers.)
- > Talking with the teachers about God's Word. (Open and read imaginary book.)
- "Where've you been?" His mother frowned. (Fold arms; make a frown.)
- Jesus said, "Right here in My Father's house." (Point to floor.)
- > And Jesus grew both wise and tall. (Reach high.)
- > He was loved by God and liked by all. (Hug self.)

Act It Out continued

JESUS IS BAPTIZED

- > At the Jordan River, (Move hand like a wave.)
- > John baptized everyone. (Hold nose and dip, as if going underwater.)
- > He preached about forgiveness. (Hug self.)
- ➤ He said the Lord would come. (Point to heaven.)
- ➤ He told them all to stop their sin (Shake finger, as if scolding.)
- > And get ready for the Lord. (Point to heaven.)
- > Then John baptized Jesus, (Hold nose and dip, as if going underwater.)
- And saw heaven's open door. (Raise both hands to heaven.)
- ➤ And then the Holy Spirit (Fold hand in prayer.)
- Came down on Jesus like a dove. (Flap arms like a bird.)
- ➤ God said, "With You I'm very pleased. (Smile.)
- > You're My Son, Whom I love." (Hug self.)

JESUS CALLS HIS DISICPLES

- > Jesus sent some men to fish after they'd caught none all day. (Show empty hands.)
- **Because Jesus said so, Simon Peter did obey.** (Salute to signal "Yes, sir!")
- > At once fished filled their nets until they began to break. (Pretend to hold net filled with fish.)
- Friends helped Simon Peter and both boats began to sink. (Bend knees, as if sinking.)
- > Jesus told Simon Peter, "Do not be afraid. (Point finger as if teaching.)
- > I'll make you fishers of men. Come, follow Me today." (Point finger out and move toward self.)
- > They brought their boats and nets and fish to shore. (Pretend to carry heavy net.)
- > They left all their things to follow Jesus forevermore! (Walk in place.)

FINAL FIVE MINUTES

PICTURE SCHEDULE: COLORING TIME

WELCOME > WORSHIP > BIBLE > CRAFT > PRAYER > SNACK > GAMES > COLORING > GOING HOME

Choose a child to remove the <u>GAMES</u> picture card and place it in the <u>FINISHED</u> envelope. **We have finished** our Game Time. Now is our time for coloring the picture of today's story.

<u>COMPLETED CRAFT</u>: Take home your "Follow Me Cards." Tell someone how Jesus said, "Come, follow Me."

<u>DAILY WAY (ADAPTATION FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES</u>): Distribute this version of the Daily Way, if available. Show the Daily Way to your family. Talk about how Jesus wants us to follow Him.

COLOR THIS STORY: "Jesus Calls His Disciples." Discuss Bible Story and play the Unit 1 Bible Memory Verse Song "Children, Obey Your Parents" or "The Word Became Flesh" as children color.

THE DAILY WAY

Unit 1, Access Lesson 4: Jesus Calls His Disciples—Part 1

PONDER! Read Luke 5:1-11 with your family. Simon Peter and his friends, James and John, had fished all night, but they had not caught any fish. Jesus told them to go fishing again and they caught lots of fish. Jesus said, "Come, follow Me." We can follow Jesus, just like Simon Peter, James, and John did.

PRAY! Pray this prayer each day this week: "Lord, thank You for calling us to follow You. Help us to listen to You and obey You every day. Amen."

PLAY! Teach your family to play "Follow the Leader." Ask your family to walk behind you and do what you do. Take turns being the leader. Remember Jesus said, "Come, follow Me." He is our leader and He wants us to follow Him everyday.
