# Jesus and Nicodemus

John 3:1-5, 16

Suggested setting: Kings & Kingdoms puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod, or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to hear Bible stories about God. The Leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, forest ranger, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction with puppets.

Leader (Stands at puppet window)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert
Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops head out of
window.) "Hellohhhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat, and Lello the Lamb pops
head out of window.)

## **Delbert**

Hee Haw! Let me hear your Hee Haw!

# **Leader & Children**

Hee Haw! Hi Delbert! Hello Lello!

# <u>Leader</u>

Hey guys. Have you two delivered any strawberries yet?

# **Delbert**

Haw! We delivered our first basket of fresh strawberries today.

#### Leader

Who did you serve first?

## <u>Lello</u>

We brought a basket to Mama Sheep and her little lamb Joey.

# **Leader**

Wonderful! I bet they loved the berries.

#### **Delbert**

They sure did. And Mama Sheep loved the note we attached. It said, "Jesus loves you!"

#### Lello

Yeah. She even thanked us for the time we watched little Joey and taught him about Jesus.

## **Leader**

That reminds me of today's Bible Story.

## Delbert

Haw! Really?

# Leader

Yes! Today we'll learn about the time Jesus taught a man named Nicodemus.

# **Lello**

Oooh. What did Jesus teach him?

# **Delbert**

Haw! Was it about God?

## Leader

It was, Delbert. Jesus taught Nicodemus that God loves us so much He sent His Son to help us.

## **Delbert**

God is good. He loves us a whoooooole lot!

# <u>Lello</u>

Yeah. And we taught little Joey just like Jesus taught Nicodemus.

# **Leader**

You did! It's good to tell others how much God loves everyone in the world.

## **Delbert**

Haw! It sure is. Come on, Lello. Let's go collect some more strawberries for our next basket.

## **Leader**

I saw some nice juicy ones near the stream. You may want to check there.

## Lello

Yeah. We will. Thanks for teaching us about Nicodemus. Bah-bye everybahhh-dy.

# **Delbert**

Haw. See you guys later.

## **Leader**

Bye guys.
