Jesus and Nicodemus

Lesson Aim: To consider personal salvation and discover the meaning of being born again.

THE WELCOME

MEET & GREET: When is your birthday?

GAME: Birthday Race

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO SERVES

Read Worship Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17.

Sing songs and worship God. (Use the Seven Stars of Lent activity if this lesson occurs during the 40 days before Easter.)

Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Kingdom Adventures script or read storybook.

Lead any child who expresses a desire to receive Jesus as his or her Lord and Savior in praying the ABC Prayer or any prayer of salvation.

THE WORD JESUS TEACHES NICODEMUS

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Jesus taught the nine blessings called the Beatitudes.

Today, we will learn about a man named Nicodemus who came by himself at night to see Jesus. Point to Jerusalem on a map.

Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: John 3:1-5, 16. Pray. Read.

THE WAY BEING BORN AGAIN

Being born again is the beginning of your new life following Jesus. It's eternal; you will live forever, even if your body dies.

Our first birth is as a baby born from a mother. Nicodemus wondered how a grownup can be born like that again. Jesus answered Nicodemus by saying that when we are born again, it is through water and the Holy Spirit. What does water do for us when we are dirty? (Washes away the dirt.) When we believe in

Jesus as our Lord, our sins are washed away and we have a new start – we are born again.

The Holy Spirit comes and lives in our hearts forever to help us follow Jesus. Choose volunteer. Instruct volunteer to place ping pong ball on flat hard surface and blow on it until it rolls. **Just as we cannot see breath or wind blowing, we cannot see the Holy Spirit. But can you see the ping pong ball move in the way the wind blows it? (Yes.) When we are born again, we are like this ping pong ball. The Holy Spirit is like the breath or wind that moves us in the right direction to keep us following Jesus.**

CHRIST CONNECTION:

More than 500 years earlier, Ezekiel spoke of God's promise to give us a new heart and a new spirit for our new life close with Him. Reveal Ezekiel 36:25-27. Highlight. Pray. Read.

Jesus says believing in Him is the only way to eternal life. If you have never accepted this gift of a new life forever close with God, and you are ready to do that, you can pray to Him about that right now and you will be born again. If a child wants to be born again, offer to lead that child in the ABC Prayer or any prayer of salvation. Give child a Children's Guide for New Believers to take home.

THE GOLDEN BOWL: Pray for individuals. Pray the Lord's Prayer.
