## THE WORD JESUS AND THE WOMAN AT THE WELL CLASSROOM PROMISE

Whisper: I have a secret. Continue until you have everyone's attention. Do you want to hear my secret? Listen very closely. "God loves you." Who can whisper my secret back to me? Return to a normal voice: That's right, God loves you. God wants us to tell others how much He loves them. Let's all say it together one more time but this time, nice and loud. Are you ready? "God loves you!"

Let's listen to our story as we learn that God wants us to tell others about Jesus. Hold Bible open to John 4:30.

WATCH THE WORD: JOHN 4:7, 25-26, 28-30, 42

Read poem. Display visual.

- One day, Jesus came to a town,
- > And by a well, He sat right down.
- > He was tired for He had traveled far.
- Then came a woman with a water jar.
- Jesus said, "Please give Me a drink."
- > As they talked, she began to think.
- "All who drink this will be thirsty again,"
- > He said, "I give life that never ends."
- > Back to her town the woman ran.
- > She said, "Everyone, come and see this Man!"
- > He told me everything I've ever done.
- > Could He be the Lord, God's only Son?"
- > The townspeople came out just to see.
- When Jesus spoke, they said "We believe."
- > "Come, see Jesus," said the woman at the well.
- > She told many people—how many can you tell?

Who did the woman tell about Jesus? (The people in town.) Did the people believe? (Yes.)
