# Jesus and the Woman at the Well

Lesson Aim: To tell others about Jesus.

## **THE WELCOME**

MEET & GREET: What is your favorite thing to drink?

**GAME:** Well Water Relay Race

## **THE WORSHIP** JESUS AS THE KING WHO SERVES

Read Worship Scripture: Revelation 21:5-7

Sing songs and worship God. (Use the Seven Stars of Lent activity if this lesson occurs during the 40 days before Easter.)

Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Kingdom Adventures script or read storybook.

## THE WORD JESUS TALKS WITH THE WOMAN AT THE WELL

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Jesus talked with Nicodemus about being born again.

**Today, we'll learn about the woman at the well who talked with Jesus about eternal life.** Point to Samaria. Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: John 4:7, 10-11, 13-14, 25-26, 28-30, 41-42. Pray. Read.

### **THE WAY** TELLING EVERYONE ABOUT JESUS

Where did Jesus talk to the woman? (At the well.) He talked with her about a special kind of water. What was the name of that special water? (Living water.) Living water stands for life forever with Jesus.

God made our hearts to be thirsty for life with Jesus. So, if we don't have Him, our hearts stay thirsty. Jesus doesn't care what we look like, where we come from, or what we have done before. As long as we choose to believe and follow Jesus, He gives us the living water. He gives us life that lasts forever with God.

What did the woman do after she talked to Jesus? (Put down her water jug and told everyone to come see Jesus.) That's what believers all over the world do today and so can you. It's easier to tell people about Jesus than you might think. We don't have to teach or give a speech. We just tell others what Jesus has done for us. That's what the woman at the well did. She went back into town and told all kinds of people what had happened to her.

**SEVEN SECONDS OF SILENCE:** Seat children around a circle of rocks, symbolizing a well. Place a bucket of drinking water nearby. Lead children in seven seconds of silence to think of what they can share about God (His power, love, living water, etc).

SHARING AT THE WELL: Choose volunteers to deliver cups and serve water. You may share your story or just enjoy the water and listen to others' good news. Who would like to share what God is doing in your life?

#### **CHRIST CONNECTION:**

Why do you think God made water? (So we won't be thirsty.) 700 years before Jesus talked about living water, God gave us another reason why He gives water. Reveal Isaiah 43:19-21. Read.

To proclaim God's praise means to tell others how great God is. How did we do that today? How can you do that at home?

**THE GOLDEN BOWL:** Pray for individuals. Pray the Lord's Prayer.
