Lesson Aim: To praise Jesus as the King
who came to save us.

THE WELCOME

TREASURE CHEST

WHISPER VERSE AND SIGN LANGUAGE: "Hosanna." It means "the Savior is coming!"

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO LOVES

It's Praise Time—our time to sing praise to the King who loves us. King Jesus rode into Jerusalem where lots and lots of boys, girls, and families welcomed Him and praised Him. Let's spend time praising King Jesus as the people did.

As Jesus rode by, the people praised Him by shouting "Hosanna!" That's our Whisper Verse for today. Review Whisper Verse together: "Hosanna!" Include sign language. **Hosanna means "the Savior is coming!" Jesus is the Savior. Let's praise Jesus now by saying "Hosanna!" together three times.**

THE WORD JESUS RIDES INTO JERUSALEM

CLASSROOM PROMISE

Last time, we learned Mary gave Jesus a special gift when she washed His feet with sweet perfume. Today, we'll hear how Jesus rode into Jerusalem as King. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Mark 11:8.

WATCH THE WORD: MARK 11:1-10

Read poem. Display visual.

- Jesus walked towards Jerusalem,
- He sent two friends ahead.
- He sent them to the village nearby,
- And this is what He said:
 - "When you reach the village,
 - A donkey you will find.
 - Untie it there and bring it here.
 - Upon it I will ride.
- Here is what to say,
- If anyone should ask:
 - 'The Lord Jesus needs this donkey.
 - Soon we will send it back.'"
- The people came to see Him ride,
- They spread coats on the ground.
- They waved palm branches in the air.
- "Hosanna," they did shout.

What did people put on the ground for Jesus' donkey to walk on? (Coats and branches.) Let's find our answer in the Bible. Read Mark 11:8 from teacher's Bible.

What did the people shout? (Hosanna!) Our Whisper Verse tells us the answer. Let's say it together: "Hosanna!" Include sign language or hand motions. It means "the Savior is coming!"
