

At-A-Glance: Ages 8-9 Kings & Kingdoms Part 1: The Life of Jesus Unit 3, Lesson 13

The Triumphal Entry

Lesson Aim: To see the noble choice Jesus made by entering Jerusalem as a humble King facing death to save us.

THE WELCOME

MEET & GREET: What is the best thing you've seen in a parade?

GAME: Are You the King?

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO LOVES

Read Worship Scripture: Revelation 7:9-10

Sing songs and worship God. (Use the Seven Stars of Lent activity if this lesson occurs during the 40 days before Easter.)

Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Kingdom Adventures script or read storybook.

THE WORD JESUS RIDES INTO JERUSALEM ON A DONKEY

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Mary poured her perfume on Jesus' feet as worship.

Today, we will check out how and why King Jesus rode into Jerusalem. Point to the town of Jerusalem. Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: Luke 19:30-32, 35-36; John 12:13; Luke 19:41-42. Find It First. Highlight Key Verse: Luke 19:41-42. Pray. Read.

THE WAY JESUS KNEW, OBEYED, LOVED, AND SAVED

Even though Jesus knew everything that would happen to Him, He chose to ride into Jerusalem so He could save us.

BODY MOVERS: HE KNEW/HE OBEYED/HE LOVED/HE SAVED

HE KNEW Snap their fingers 3 times.

HE OBEYED Shout "YES!"

HE LOVED Stomp their feet until you hand signal stop. **HE SAVED** Raise both hands and shout Hallelujah!

How did Jesus' instructions to His followers about the donkey show HE KNEW the future? (He already knew the colt was tied up. He planned everything beforehand.) HE KNEW the owners would give the colt for the Lord. HE KNEW it was the right time to come to Jerusalem.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

To see proof Jesus already knew what would happen that day, check out what the Lord said through Zechariah nearly 500 years earlier. Reveal Zechariah 9:9 Find It First. Highlight. Read.

Continue Body Movers game. HE KNEW when He entered the city there were only a few days until He would die on the cross. How was riding into the city a picture of how HE OBEYED? (He chose to do what God had sent Him to do.)

Why do you think Jesus wept for the people? That's right, HE LOVED the people – even the ones who would not believe in Him! How do you feel when someone you love doesn't believe in Jesus? HE KNEW how hard life would be for anyone who refused to believe in Him, that's why He wept for them.

Do you know what "Hosanna" means in Hebrew? ("Save!" or "Here comes the Savior!") The crowd thought He was going to save them from the Roman government, but what was He actually coming to save the people from? (He saves all who believed in Him from a life forever without God.) He SAVED all who believed in Him from the punishment for their sins. HE SAVED them from a life forever without God.

THE GOLDEN BOWL: Pray for individuals. Pray the Lord's Prayer.
