# THE WORD JESUS SHARES THE LAST SUPPER CLASSROOM PROMISE

Place the three holiday items, the bread, and the cup in the bag. I have some special items with me today. Let's see if you can tell me what they remind you of. Pull the first holiday item out of the bag. What special time does this remind you of? Pull the second holiday item out of the bag. How about this? What does it remind you of? Share a memory you have about that holiday or special event. Pull the third holiday item out of the bag. What special time does this

remind you of? I love to remember special times I've shared with family and friends. Today, we will hear how Jesus shared a special time with His friends. Remove the bread and cup from the bag. Jesus used bread and a cup to help them remember Him and the special time they had together. Let's find out how.

Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Luke 22:19a.

#### WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 22:14, 19-20

Read poem. Display visual.
