Kings & Kingdoms Part 1: The Life of Jesus
Unit 3, Lesson 17

The Cross: Peter Denies Jesus

Luke 22:54-62

Suggested setting: Kings & Kingdoms puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod, or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to hear Bible stories about God. The Leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, forest ranger, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction with puppets.

Leader (Stands at puppet window)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhl-bert
Dehhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops head out of
window.) "Hellohhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops
head out of window.)

Delbert

Hee Haw! Let me hear your Hee Haw!

<u>Leader & Children</u> Hee Haw! Hi, Delbert. <u>Leader</u>

Delbert, where is Lello?

Delbert

She is praying in our garden. She'll be here soon.

Leader

Oh good. Did you pray in your garden this week, too?

Delbert

I did. I'm so glad you taught me that God hears our prayers everywhere.

<u>Lello</u>

(Lello pops up.) Yeah. (bleat) Hello everybahhh-dy. Sorry I'm late.

Leader

That's ok. May I ask what you were praying about?

<u>Lello</u>

Yeah. I found out today that Jesus died on the cross for me. So I thanked Him in my prayer.

Delbert

Haw! Jesus died on the cross? How sad.

Leader

It is sad, but it's also very good.

Delbert

How could that be good?

Lello

Delbert, Jesus died for us so that we could be with God forever.

Delbert

Haw! Really! That is good. But I bet it was a hard time for Jesus' friends.

<u>Lello</u>

Yeah. If I was there, I would have been afraid.

Leader

You're right Delbert. Peter was so afraid that he even said he didn't know Jesus.

Lello

Oh dear. Jesus must have been sad.

Leader

Yes, but Jesus already knew about it. He knew Peter would say he didn't know Jesus before the rooster crowed three times.

Delbert

And it happened, just as Jesus said, it would. (Delbert crows.)

Lello

Wow! Jesus knows everything.

Leader

That's right! Jesus even knew that after He died for us, God would make Him alive again!

Delbert

Haw. Jesus knew all about that, and He knows all about us, too.

Lello

Really? I am so glad that I know Jesus.

Delbert

Haw! We can tell our friends all that we know about Jesus.

Leader

That'd be great. Jesus wants everyone to know Him.

Delbert

Haw! Come on Lello. Let's go tell our friends all about Jesus. See you later!

Lello

Yeah. Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy.

Leader

Bye guys.
