The Road to Emmaus

Lesson Aim: To recognize who Jesus is
and what He has done.

THE WELCOME

MEET & GREET: What is the farthest you have ever walked?

GAME: Race to Emmaus

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO ROSE

Read Worship Scripture: Psalm 119:105

Sing songs and worship God.

Bless and collect the offering.

Perform Kingdom Adventures script or read storybook.

THE WORD JESUS APPEARS AND EXPLAINS WHO HE IS

Children sign note cards; place in Golden Bowl. Classroom Covenant.

Review: Jesus died on the cross and then rose from the dead.

Later that day, Jesus walked with two followers on the road to Emmaus. They did not recognize Him. Point to Jerusalem and the road to Emmaus. Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: Luke 24:13-18, 27-31. Find It First. Highlight Key Verse: Luke 24:31. Pray. Read.

THE WAY RECOGNIZING JESUS IN THE BIBLE

Why do you think that the men were kept from recognizing Jesus at first? The men were not expecting to see Jesus because they did not understand that Jesus had risen. They were so sad that they did not notice that Jesus was with them.

Even though the tomb was empty and Jesus had already told them He would rise, they still could not believe it. So Jesus used the Bible (the Scriptures) to explain everything. The Bible has many clues about Jesus that were given by Moses and the prophets. The clues helped them see Jesus was the Savior the Bible had promised would come. What Bible story has helped you understand something important about Jesus?

When did the men finally know it was Jesus who had been walking and talking with them? (When Jesus gave thanks for the bread, broke it and ate with the men.)

Four nights earlier at the Last Supper, Jesus gave thanks and broke the bread. How does the visit on the road to Emmaus remind you of the Last Supper? (Both times, Jesus gave thanks, broke the bread.) **Next time you eat bread, give thanks and think about how Jesus has been walking and talking with you all day!**

What did Jesus do after the men recognized Him? (Disappeared.)

CHRIST CONNECTION:

The Bible is divided into two parts called the Old and New Testaments. The Old Testament begins with God's creation of the world. The New Testament begins with the birth of Jesus. The Old Testament gives many clues called prophecies that point to Jesus as our Savior. For example, 700 years before Jesus lived on the earth, the prophet Isaiah wrote about some of the miracles Jesus would perform. Reveal Isaiah 35:5. Find It First. Highlight. Read.

When Jesus lived on the earth, He healed the blind man and the deaf man. These are just two of the many miracles Jesus performed. Isaiah's words came true and helped some people see Jesus was the one God had sent to save them.

If time allows, play CHRIST CONNECTION CARDS in GOT TIME?.
