Lesson Aim: To tell other people about Jesus.

THE WELCOME TREASURE CHEST

WHISPER VERSE AND SIGN LANGUAGE: "Tell the world."

THE WORSHIP JESUS AS THE KING WHO ROSE

It's Praise Time—our time to sing praise to the King who rose to life. Just before He rose up to His throne in heaven, Jesus told His followers to go and tell the world about Him. That is our **Whisper Verse** today. Let's try it together. Review Whisper Verse together: "Tell the world." Include sign language.

One thing we can tell the world is Jesus is the King who rose to life. Let's honor King Jesus now by listening to this song as we give our money offering.

What else can we tell the world about King Jesus? Those are great ideas! We can tell the world Jesus loves everyone. Sing: "Jesus Loves The Little Children."

When we tell the world about Jesus, it's as if we are saying, "Jesus, we love You!" Do you think Jesus likes to hear that? (Yes.) Let's tell Jesus we love Him as we sing our Bible Memory Verse Song. Sing: "Do You Love Me?"

Another way to show Jesus we love Him is to go wherever He sends us to tell others about Him. Sing: "Here I Am Send Me."

THE WORD JESUS SENDS OUT HIS FOLLOWERS CLASSROOM PROMISE

Last week, we learned Jesus appeared to two men after He had risen. He walked and ate supper with them. Today, we will hear how Jesus talked with Peter after Jesus had risen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Matthew 28:20b.

WATCH THE WORD: MATTHEW 28:16-20

Read poem. Display visual.

- Jesus sent His followers to Galilee.
- They went to the mountain where He said He'd be.
- They saw Jesus and they worshipped Him.
- This is what Jesus said to them:
- "Go and tell the world about Me.
- Tell each person that you see.
- Teach them to follow and obey,
- And I'll be with you all the way."

Who will always be with you? (Jesus.) Let's find our answer in the Bible. Read Matthew 28:20b from teacher's Bible.

Who can we tell about Jesus? (Anyone in the world.) Our Whisper Verse tells us the answer. Let's say it together: "Tell the world." Include sign language or hand motions.
