Kings & Kingdoms Part 2: Judges through Esther
Unit 7, Lesson 33

Deborah, the Judge

Judges 4:4-5, 5:7

Suggested setting: The Kings & Kingdoms puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds, and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to learn more about Jesus and the Bible. The leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, a farmer, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction.

Leader (Stands at puppet stage.)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert
Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops head out of
window.) "Hellohhhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops
head out of window.)

Delbert

Hee Haw! Hi, everybody. Oh, hello, Lello! Thanks for helping Beaker and me today!

<u>Leader</u>

What's this?

Delbert

Haw, my friend Beaker the Duck and I were having a problem.

Leader

Oh, dear. What happened?

Delbert

Beaker and I made a fort together. I wanted to be the king, but Beaker wouldn't let me have a turn.

Leader

Oh my, that is a problem. What happened?

Delbert

Just then, Lello came along. She helped us decide what was fair.

Leader

Just like a judge.

Lello

What's a judge?

Leader

A judge is someone who decides what is right and fair.

Delbert

Just like Lello!

Lello

Yeah. Oh, I'd like to hear more about judges. Were there any judges in the Bible?

Leader

Yes! God sent judges to help his people. One judge was a woman named Deborah.

Delbert

Haw! What did she do?

Leader

Deborah sat under a palm tree. People came there to tell her about their problems and Deborah decided what was right and fair.

Delbert

That's great! I bet the people were happy God sent Deborah.

Leader

Yes, and did you know God gives us people like Deborah, too?

Lello

He does? Who?

Leader

Well, our teachers can help us decide what is fair.

Lello

And our parents and grandparents, right?

Leader

Right.

Delbert

And, Lello! You were like a judge today! Hey, let's go find Beaker. We can tell him what we learned about judges.

Lello

Yeah, and maybe we can take turns pretending we are Deborah. We can all sit under a tree and decide what is fair.

Leader

That sounds like a great idea. We'll see you soon.

Lello

Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy.

Delbert

See you guys later. (Braying)

(All exit.)
