The Adventures of Delbert and Lello
Kings & Kingdoms Part 2: Judges through Esther
Unit 8, Lesson 41

David's Heart: David Praises God

2 Samuel 6:5, 12-15

Suggested setting: The Kings & Kingdoms puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds, and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to learn more about Jesus and the Bible. The leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, a farmer, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction.

<u>**Props**</u> Two percussion instruments (tambourine, maraca, etc.)

Leader (Stands at puppet stage.)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert
Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops head out of
window.) "Hellohhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops
head out of window.)

<u>Delbert</u> (Delbert pops up.) Hee Haw! <u>Lello</u> (Lello pops up.) Hello every-bahhh-dy.

<u>Leader</u> (to Delbert and Lello) **Welcome!**

Delbert

Haw! I love to praise God! It's so much fun.

Lello

It is fun and it's even more fun to praise God with our friends.

Leader

Delbert, what is your favorite way to praise God?

Delbert

My favorite way is with music. You can praise God with... (Delbert pops down and returns with a percussion instrument in his mouth. He shakes it 3 times.)

Leader

Yes, with a <u>Delbert's instrument!</u> What a great idea! (Takes Delbert's instrument.)

Lello

Or you can praise God with... (Lello pops down and returns with a different percussion instrument in her mouth and shakes it 3 times.)

<u>Leader</u> (Takes Lello's instrument.) With a <u>Lello's instrument!</u> Those are both great ways to praise God.

Delbert

Haw! I've got one more. You can praise God with a trumpet. (Delbert pops down, but comes up without a trumpet.)

<u>Leader</u>

Where's your trumpet?

Delbert

I couldn't find it. What should I do?

Lello

I have an idea. Let's *pretend* we are playing trumpets!

Leader

Come on, boys and girls. Let's all play our trumpets!

<u>Delbert, Lello, Leader, and Children</u> <u>Doot-doot!</u> (Lead children in making 3 trumpet sounds.)

Delbert

Haw! That was great!

Leader

Yes, it was! Did you know King David loved to praise God?

Lello

He did?

Leader

Yes, he did. In today's story, King David praised God by playing music, singing, and dancing.

Delbert

Haw. I love to dance! Boys and girls, will you play your trumpets while I dance for God?

<u>Lello</u>

Yeah, let's praise God together! Here we go!

Lello, Leader, and Children

(Make 3 trumpet sounds 4 times. Leader also plays one of the percussion instruments. Delbert dances.)

Doot-doot-doot! Doot-doot-doot! Doot-doot-doot! Doot-doot-doot!

Lello

It's fun to dance before the Lord. Delbert, let's go find some of our animal friends and invite them to dance, too!

Delbert

That sounds great. You guys can have fun praising God right here with your Praise Time friends! See you guys later. (braying)

<u>Lello</u>

Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy.

Leader

We'll see you soon.

(All exit.)
