THE WORD SOLOMON ASKED FOR WISDOM CLASSROOM PROMISE

Hold up the phone. Who can tell me what this is? (A phone.) What do we use phones for? (To talk to people.) Can we use a phone to talk to God? (No.) How do we talk to God? (Prayer.) God loves when we talk with Him. When we pray, we can ask God to help us. One night when King Solomon was talking to God, he asked Him for something very important. Let's find out what it was. Handle the Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to 1 Kings 3:5.

WATCH THE WORD: 1 KINGS 3:5-14

Read poem. Display visual.

- In a dream God told King Solomon,
- "Ask Me for anything."
- King Solomon prayed, "Let my heart be wise,
- > So I can be a good king."
- He did not ask for riches,
- Or other selfish things.
- So, God gave Solomon the wisest heart,
- > And more riches than the other kings.

Who talked to King Solomon in his dream? (God.) What did King Solomon ask from God? (To be wise.)
