## Day 5

Read 2 Kings 23:25.

More than any other king, Josiah obeyed God  with all his heart, soul and strength.

## Day 4

Read 2 Kings 23:1-6.

## Day 3

Read 2 Kings 22:18-19.

God heard and forgave King Josiah because he  didn't know the law.  pouted.  
 was truly sorry from his heart.

## Day 2

Read 2 Kings 22:8, 11-14.

When King Josiah heard the laws he was not keeping, he was so sad he  broke his royal crown.  
 tore his royal robes.  
 threw his royal scepter.

## Day 1

Read 2 Kings 22:1-2.

How old was Josiah when he became king?

What law would you make if you were king or queen?

**KING JOSIAH OBEYS**  
 2 Kings 22:1-2, 8, 11-14, 18-19; 23:1-6, 25

Josiah was 8 years old when he became king. When the Book of the Law was found in the temple, King Josiah learned about some of God's laws he had not kept. He tore his robes and cried. He promised to obey God's laws. He read the Book of the Law to God's people. They promised to obey, too. There has never been a king who turned to God with all his heart, soul and strength as Josiah did.
