# Ezra Teaches God's People Ezra 7:6, 8-10

<u>Lello (</u>pops up) Hello every-bahhh-dy.

Leader (to Delbert and Lello) Delbert, where did you get that robe?

## Delbert

From Lello. She has been helping me with my king costume. I've been practicing to be King Josiah. I hope I get to be him in the school play.

## Lello

Yeah, and Delbert has done a great job obeying, just like King Josiah did.

## <u>Leader</u>

But Delbert, I thought you wanted to be King Solomon because he was so wise.

## Delbert

I did, but God liked the way King Josiah obeyed. I think that sometimes it is hard to obey!

## Leader

It sure is. We're been learning about a lot of kings, haven't we?

## <u>Lello</u>

Yeah, I didn't know there were so many stories about kings in the Bible.

**Suggested setting:** The Kings & Kingdoms puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds, and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

**Characters:** Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to learn more about Jesus and the Bible. The leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, a farmer, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction.

**Props:** Delbert wears a crown and robe.

Leader (Stands at puppet stage.) It's time to call for Delbert and Lello. Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and Delbert the Donkey pops head out of window.) "HellohhhhhhhhhhhhhhhLello!" (Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops head out of window.)

Delbert (wearing crown and robe) Hee Haw!

Delbert Haw! I love to learn the Bible stories.

<u>Leader</u> I know someone else who loved to learn about the Bible.

<u>Delbert</u> Who?

#### Leader

Ezra. In Bible times, Ezra loved to learn God's rules and he loved to teach others.

<u>Lello</u> Why did Ezra love to do that?

Leader

Ezra wanted everyone to know God's rules so they could obey them.

Delbert Haw. How can we learn God's rules?

<u>Leader</u> We learn them from the Bible.

<u>Lello</u> Yeah, I love it when my teacher tells me Bible stories.

<u>Leader</u> That's right. What's one of your favorite stories?

Delbert I love the story of Noah and hearing how he built that big ark!

Leader Next time, I'll teach you about another person who liked to build for God.

Lello Can I come and learn, too? <u>Leader</u> Oh, of course!

<u>Delbert</u> Lello, let's go work on my king costume some more.

#### <u>Lello</u>

And if we see any of our friends, we can teach them about the kings in the Bible.

<u>Delbert</u> Haw! They'll like that!! See you guys later.

<u>Lello</u> Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy.

<u>Leader</u> We'll see you soon.

(All exit.)
