Read Ezra 7:6, 9-10.

King Artaxerxes gave Ezra everything he wanted because

**EZRA TEACHES GOD'S PEOPLE**  
Ezra 7:6, 9-10, 23-26;  
9:6, 9-10; 10:1, 11-12

Ezra loved to teach God's law. After Zerubbabel rebuilt the temple, King Artaxerxes sent Ezra to teach God's law to His people. Ezra saw that God's people were disobeying the law. He confessed and asked God for forgiveness. The men, women and children cried about their sins. Ezra gathered everyone together outside the temple. They agreed to repent!
