# The Promise of the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:3-11

Suggested setting: The Prophets & Promises puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds, and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to learn more about Jesus and the Bible. The leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, a farmer, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction.

Leader (Stands at puppet stage.)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert
Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops head out of
window.) "Hellohhhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops
head out of window.)

### **Delbert**

Hee Haw! Hello, everybody!

Lello (bleats)

Yeah. Hello, every-bahhh-dy.

# **Leader**

It's great to see you two. Did you have a nice Christmas? (Lello is busy looking around. She is not paying attention.)

# **Delbert**

Haw! It was great. I had so much fun seeing my family and opening gifts.

### Leader

And how about you, Lello? (Lello is distracted and does not respond.)

### Delbert

Lello? Hello, Lello.

### Lello

Yeah? Oh, I'm sorry.

### Leader

That's ok. Is everything alright?

### Lello

Oh, yes. I'm just looking for the mailman.

### Delbert

Why are you looking for him?

### Lello

My grandmother told me that a special gift would be coming in the mail, but it's so hard to wait.

# **Leader**

It is hard to wait. That reminds me of our Whisper Verse. Boys and girls, let's tell Lello and Delbert today's Whisper Verse. Ready?

# **Leader and Children**

"Wait for the gift."

# **Delbert**

Haw! You mean Jesus wants us to wait?

## Leader

That's right. In the Bible, Jesus told His followers to wait for the gift.

# Lello

Oooh. What gift did they have to wait for?

### **Delbert**

Was it a racecar like the one I got for Christmas?

# **Leader**

No. The gift Jesus was talking about was the Holy Spirit.

### **Delbert**

Haw! What is that?

# **Leader**

The Holy Spirit is God. He is the part of God that is our special helper. Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to His followers.

### Lello

Wow! That is a gift worth waiting for. And I know the gift my grandmother sent is worth waiting for, too.

### **Delbert**

Lello, why don't we go wait for the mailman together?

### Lello

Yeah, that sounds like a great idea. Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy!

# **Delbert**

Haw! See you guys later! (braying)

# Leader

We'll see you soon.

(All exit.)
