Pentecost: The Holy Spirit Comes

Lesson Aim: To know God keeps His promises.

THE WELCOME

TREASURE CHEST

WHISPER VERSE AND SIGN LANGUAGE: "The Lord has kept the promise."

THE WORSHIP THE SPIRIT WHO GIVES US POWER

Sing Bible Memory Verse and other related songs.

It's Praise Time—our time to sing praise to the Holy Spirit who gives us power. Jesus promised His friends that He would send the gift of the Holy Spirit to them. Today, we will celebrate the way Jesus kept His promise and sent the Holy Spirit. That reminds me of today's Whisper Verse: "The Lord has kept the promise." Let's try it together now. Review Whisper Verse together: "The Lord has kept the promise." Include sign language.

The Holy Spirit is our helper. He is with us wherever we go. Sing: "I Am with You" while collecting the offering.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

Jesus kept His promise to send the Holy Spirit. He always keeps His promises. Sing: "The Lord Is Faithful."

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

In today's story, we will see how the Lord kept His promise to pour out His Spirit on all people. Let's sing about that promise. Sing: "Not by Might."

THE WORD JESUS PROMISES TO SEND THE HOLY SPIRIT CLASSROOM PROMISE

Last time, we learned Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit. Today, we will hear how Jesus kept His promise. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Acts 2:2.

WATCH THE WORD: ACTS 2:1-4

Read poem. Display visual.

- > Jesus had told His friends to wait for the gift.
- > So, they waited together in town.
- > Then came the holiday called Pentecost,
- > And they all heard a very strange sound.
- > It was heaven's wind blowing through the house.
- A small flame rested on each one.
- They spoke in many languages to the crowd,
- > For the gift of the Holy Spirit had come.

What sound did Jesus' friends hear? (Wind.) Let's find our answer in the Bible. Read Acts 2:2 from the teacher's Bible.

Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit. Did Jesus keep His promise? (Yes.) Our Whisper Verse tells us the answer. Let's say it together: "The Lord has kept the promise." Include sign language or hand motions. Remember, "Lord" is another name for God.
