THE WORD A PROMISE FOR MARY CLASSROOM PROMISE

Hold the baby. Last time, we talked about a very special baby. Do you remember who that baby was? (Jesus.) God told a man named Isaiah that He promised to send baby Jesus to the world.

Do you remember what a promise is? A promise is something we tell someone we will do. Who always keeps His promises? (God.)

In today's story, we will hear God's promise to a young woman named Mary. Do you know who Mary was? (Jesus' mother.) That's right! Let's listen to Mary's story. Handle the Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Luke 1:31.

WATCH THE WORD: LUKE 1:26-38

Read poem. Display visual.

- > The angel Gabriel came to Mary,
- > And said, "Do not be afraid,
- > For the Lord is pleased with you!
- > Here is the promise He made:
- "You will have a baby boy.
- Name Him Jesus when He is born.
- Jesus is the Son of God;
- ➤ He will be King forevermore!"

Who was the special baby in our story today? (Jesus.) Jesus is God's Son and He is King of everything!
