JOHN THE BAPTIST POINTS US TO JESUS
Luke 1:41, 76-79; 3:4-6
John was a prophet in the desert who told people to prepare the way for Jesus. 700 years earlier, the prophet Isaiah wrote, "A messenger is calling out in the desert, 'Prepare the way for the Lord. Make straight paths for Him. Every valley will be filled in. Every mountain and hill will become level. The rough ways will be made smooth. And everyone will see God's salvation.'"
