SAUL ESCAPED FROM DAMASCUS

Acts 9:19-25

God sent Ananias to visit Saul so his eyes would be healed and he'd be filled with the Spirit. At once Saul began to preach. He taught that Jesus is God's Son and all who heard him were amazed. But the Jews planned to stop Saul from telling people about Jesus. Saul's friends helped him escape at night. They lowered him in a basket through an opening in the city wall.
