Because Cornelius was a Gentile, it was against Jewish law for Peter to visit his house. Peter knew God wanted him to stay out. go inside. run.

What is a Gentile?

A Gentile is someone who is not a Jew. Jesus came to save the Jews and the Gentiles. He came for everybody!

PETER VISITS CORNELIUS
Acts 10:9-36, 42-48

Peter was Jewish. In a dream, God showed him he could eat the same foods that Gentiles (non-Jews) ate. God said, "Do not call anything impure that God has made clean." Peter knew this meant Jesus came for all who would believe in Him. When the Gentile Cornelius invited him to his home, Peter told all of the Gentiles there that Jesus came for them, too. They believed and were baptized!
