THE WORD PAUL TOLD HIS STORY CLASSROOM PROMISE

Today, I brought with me a very special book. Can anyone guess what I brought? (The Bible.) Show children the Bible you brought. Why is the Bible special? (Children respond.) The Bible is full of people who shared their stories about Jesus. They shared their stories so we can know Jesus and believe in Him. Paul wanted to share his story about Jesus with the crowd in Jerusalem. Let's

listen. Handle the Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Acts 21:40.

WATCH THE WORD: ACTS 21:33-36, 39-40; 22:1-11

Read poem. Display visual.

- Paul went to Jerusalem
- To help the believers there.
- An angry crowd tried to stop him;
- He was arrested near the stairs.
- Soldiers carried Paul to the steps,
- Where he stood and said, "Let me speak."
- He told the crowd about Jesus,
- And about the day Paul first believed.

What did Paul want to tell the people? (His story about Jesus.)

What did Paul say? ("Let me speak.")
