PAUL'S ARREST IN JERUSALEM
Acts 21:27, 30-40;
22:1-2, 6-8, 21; 23:1, 9-24
The church in Jerusalem welcomed Paul. But some Jews from Asia stirred up an angry crowd and grabbed Paul. The soldiers who arrested Paul had to carry him to stop the crowd from killing him. Paul asked the soldiers to let him speak to the crowd. Paul told them how Jesus had changed his heart. He wanted everyone, even his enemies, to believe and be saved.
