PAUL IMPRISONED IN ROME Acts 28:16-31

As a Roman prisoner, Paul did not have to live in a prison cell. Instead, he was guarded in a house that he rented. He invited the Jewish leaders of Rome to meet with him there. Paul boldly told them that Jesus was the Savior promised by the prophets. Some listened, but most of them did not. Paul spent the next two years in that house telling everyone about Jesus.
