LETTERS ABOUT FORGIVING OTHERS Colossians 3:12-13 & 1 Corinthians 13:5

In Paul's letter to the Colossians, he wrote: "You are God's chosen people. You are holy and dearly loved. So put on tender mercy and kindness as if they were your clothes. Don't be proud. Be gentle and patient. Put up with each other. Forgive the things you are holding against one another. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you." When the Lord forgives us, He keeps no record of our wrongs.
