THE WORD KEEPING YOUR EYES ON JESUS CLASSROOM PROMISE

Look through the binoculars at the children. I see <u>child's name</u>, and <u>another child's name</u>. Name several or all the children. When I look at you through the binoculars, I am keeping my eyes on you.

Let's play a game. This time, I want you to keep your eyes on me and do everything I do. Lead the children through several motions such as clapping, tapping your head, touching your nose, wiggling your fingers, or raising a hand in the air. That was an easy game, wasn't it? As long as you kept your eyes on me, you knew exactly what I wanted you to do.

In the Bible, there are special letters written by believers to people like you and me. In today's letter, we will learn to keep our eyes on Jesus. Can we see Jesus? (No.) Someday we will see Him in heaven, but until then we have the Bible to tell us what Jesus wants us to say and do. Who would like to open the Special Delivery Mailbox for this week's letter? Choose a child to open the mailbox, remove the Bible, and hand it to you. We can find it in Hebrews 12:1-3.

WATCH THE WORD: HEBREWS 12:1-3 Read the letter. Display visual.
