Review: Jesus told John what to write to the seven churches.

Today, we will learn about John's vision of Jesus coming back to take us to heaven. God revealed to John what it will be like when Jesus comes back to earth and what heaven looks like. That is why the last book of the Bible is called the book of Revelation. In John's vision, he described what everyone will see when Jesus comes back to earth. Reveal Bible Story Scripture Reference: 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; Revelation 19:11-16; 21:1-4; 22:20. Find It First. Highlight Key Verse: Revelation 22:20. Pray. Read.

THE WAY WE WILL SEE JESUS

Jesus gives John a vision of what will happen in the future. Who is the rider on the white horse that is called Faithful and True? (Jesus.) Imagine what it will be like to see Jesus coming with the clouds, riding on the white horse with all of heaven's armies behind Him! What is your favorite part about the description of the rider on the white horse listed in Revelation 19:12-16?

What did Jesus say that He is coming to do? Jesus is coming to judge the earth, to make war against evil, and to take believers to heaven. Right now, many things happen that are not fair and many evildoers go unpunished for hurting others. When Jesus comes, He

will fairly judge everyone with perfect justice, including the evildoers. He will rule the world and be the best King of all kings. What are you most looking forward to about Jesus' return?

The hard times we have here on earth will not be in heaven. What does John say that we will not see in heaven? (There will be no death, no mourning or crying or pain.) Paul tell us to encourage one another with the Bible's promise that Jesus will come back to take us all to heaven. How does that truth give you courage? Who do you know that needs to hear that encouragement this week?

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Over 600 years before John's vision of Jesus, God gave the prophet Daniel the same kind of vision. Both called Jesus "the Son of Man." Daniel called God the Father "the Ancient of Days." Reveal Daniel 7:13-14. Find It First. Highlight. Read. When Jesus returns, He will gather all believers and take us to heaven. It will be a perfect place where everything is right and fair and good. What do you think your favorite thing about heaven will be?

We just finished learning about the last book in the Bible! What did Jesus promise on the last page? ("I am coming soon.") Distribute bookmarks. When you look at the clouds on this bookmark and read Jesus' final words, remember His last promise. No one knows the exact time Jesus will come because God's timing is not ours. We do know the day will be the beginning of a new story where believers live forever in heaven with Jesus. Until then, we are to point others to Jesus, so they might believe and one day go to heaven.
