ELIJAH ON MOUNT CARMEL
1 Kings 18:18-21, 23-24, 26-27, 29, 30-39
King Ahab misled many Israelites to worship a false god named Baal. Elijah challenged Baal's prophets to build an altar on Mount Carmel and ask Baal to send fire to light it. They called to Baal, but there was no answer. Elijah soaked the altar with so much water, it even filled the trench. When Elijah called Him, God sent fire so others would know that the Lord is God.
