# God Sends Fire to Elijah

1 Kings 18:24-39

Suggested setting: The Prophets & Promises puppet scripts adapt to any setting such as a garden, forest, farm, or stable. Once or twice a year, a set change or addition to the set is recommended for added interest. Decorate with colorful flowers, butterflies, birds, and ladybugs. Puppets can pop out from behind a window, hedge, tree hollow, stonewall, etc. For a simple, portable puppet stage, puppets can pop up from behind a colorful blanket hung on a rod or from behind a card table turned on its side. Adjust setting and puppet names according to available puppeteers and resources.

<u>Characters</u>: Delbert the Donkey and Lello the Lamb are good friends who are always excited to learn more about Jesus and the Bible. The leader is the children's teacher or worship leader dressed in regular clothing or in costume consistent with the set (a gardener, a farmer, etc.) The leader helps children focus on the puppets and leads group interaction.

Leader (stands at puppet stage)
It's time to call for Delbert and Lello.
Repeat after me, "Dehhhhhl-bert
Dehhhhhl-bert!" (Children repeat and
Delbert the Donkey pops his head out of the
window.) Hellohhhhhhhhhhh Lello!"
(Children repeat and Lello the Lamb pops
her head out of the window.)

#### Delbert

Hee Haw! Hello everybody!

**Lello** (bleats)

Yeah. Hello every-bahhh-dy. I'm ready to learn more about God's power. Are you ready boys and girls?

Leader (pause for children's response)
I know they are! Today, we are
learning another story about God and
Elijah.

## Delbert

Haw! I can't wait. What's this story about?

## Leader

Elijah wanted to show everyone that God was the only true God, so he gathered all the people. Then, he built an altar.

#### Delbert

What's an altar?

## Leader

It's a special place to give offerings to God. To build the altar, first he laid down twelve stones, one for each family. Then, he dug a trench around the altar.

## Lello

Yeah. A trench is like a long hole ... um ... a ditch, right?

## **Leader**

That's right, Lello. Then, Elijah put firewood on the altar.

# **Delbert**

Twelve stones, a trench, firewood. Haw! That sounds like alot of work.

## **Leader**

Yes, but that wasn't all.

## Lello

It wasn't it? What else did Elijah do?

# **Leader**

Then, he put the offering to God on the altar. Next, he told the people to fill four buckets of water and pour them over the altar.

# **Delbert**

Wow! That's alot of water.

# **Leader**

Yes, then he said to do it again and again.

#### Lello

Four buckets, plus four buckets, plus four buckets ... that's 12 buckets of water!

# **Delbert**

And then what happened?

# **Leader**

Then, Elijah prayed God would show all the people He was the one true God. God answered by sending down fire that burned the altar.

Wow! Even with all that water everywhere?

## Leader

Yes. God's power is so great that the fire even burned up all the water.

# **Delbert**

All twelve buckets of water! Haw. God is powerful!

# <u>Le</u>llo

Yeah. God is the one true God. Delbert, we should go tell this story to our friends.

## **Delbert**

Haw! Great idea. See you guys later!

## Lello

Yeah. Bah-bye every-bahhh-dy!

# <u>Leader</u>

We'll see you soon.

(All exit.)
