What is a plumb line?

It's a small weight hanging from a cord. If you hang it next to a wall, you can see if the wall is upright and straight.

AMOS AND THE PLUMB LINE
Amos 4:12b-13; 5:14; 7:7-8

Amos was a shepherd and a fig farmer. A fig is a fruit that grows on a tree. God gave Amos a warning for the people: "Prepare to meet your God." They had become selfish and greedy, treating others unfairly. In a vision from God, Amos saw God holding a plumb line next to a wall. This was a sign that God was using His own measure (the Bible) to decide whether or not His people were living upright or crooked lives.
